Quilt Cabernet (Napa Valley, California) \$99

Quilt wines, produced by Joseph Wagner, are known for their bold, rich, and decadent flavors. Dark fruit like blackberry and cherry along with chocolate and vanilla and hints of oak make this Napa Valley Cabernet a winning choice.

Camigliano, Brunello Di Montalcino (Tuscany, Italy) \$135

Classic Brunello with deep notes of ripe cherry, blackberry, leather, and spice, supported by firm tannins and an elegant, lingering finish.

Silver Oak, Cabernet Sauvignon (Alexander Valley) \$199

Smooth and full-bodied Cabernet with rich flavors of blackberry, cassis, vanilla, and toasted oak, leading to a long, polished finish.

Pio Cesare, Barolo (Piedmont, Italy) \$215

Elegant and structured Barolo with notes of rose petals, cherry, leather, and spice, balanced by firm tannins and a long, refined finish.

Supremus, Toscana (Tuscany, Italy) \$65

Bold Tuscan red with layers of ripe black cherry, plum, spice, and toasted oak, finished with velvety tannins and balanced depth

Amarone Della Vapolicella (Veneto, Italy) \$72

Full-bodied and velvety Italian red with rich notes of dark cherry, dried fig, plum,

Domaine Drouhin-Vaudon Chablis (Burgundy, France) \$65

Crisp and mineral-driven Chardonnay with bright citrus, green apple, and subtle floral notes, finished with refreshing acidity and elegance.

Champagne Drappier Brut Blanc de Blancs (Champagne, France) \$180

Fresh and vibrant Blanc de Blancs Champagne with notes of citrus, pear, and brioche, complemented by fine bubbles and a crisp, elegant finish.
