What to Expect



Processing Timeline

Social Security typically takes 2–8 weeks to process your Medicare application. Timing depends on your local Social Security office and their current workload.

Watch your Mail from SSA

You'll receive a confirmation letter or email stating your application was received. You may also receive a request for more information—like proof of prior health coverage or employment. Once approved, you'll get your red, white, and blue Medicare card in the mail with your new Medicare number. 📌 Important: Open all mail from the Social Security Administration or Medicare right away, and let us know if you're unsure about anything.
