Friends, Robyn and I cannot thank you enough for your prayers and support during the recent illness and death of Robyn's mother, Gladys Pino Lucas.

Gladys, Mom, was born in 1916 (that's right, she was 102!) and grew up in rural Baton Rouge, Louisiana. She was quick to tell you she was "Creole, not Cajun."

Mom had a great sense of humor, and was totally devoted to Robyn's Dad, Richard A. Lucas, MD, a general surgeon in Austin, Texas. Mom was a loving mother to four daughters (Robyn's the baby), and had two grandchildren and three great-grands.

A couple of weeks ago, when it became clear that Mom would not recover from her illness, I was sharing with my colleagues on the Cabinet our prayer that Mom would go ahead and cross over into heaven, and our frustration at the extraordinary medical measures being employed to keep her earthbound. Bishop Schnase commented: "It sounds like you and Robyn view death as a friend, and not the enemy."

That's right! We are Easter People. We know that this life, as precious and joyful as it is, is not our final destination. Christ Is Risen! We believe that Jesus has gone before us into heaven to prepare a place for each of us who follow him.

I want to encourage each of you, in this Easter season, to proclaim that Jesus Christ is alive! Each of us will face death, of loved ones and of our own earthly bodies; but death is not our enemy – because Jesus has conquered death, has entered heaven, and is making a place there for each one of us. Early Response Teams (ERT) are specially trained teams that offer assistance soon after the disaster strikes. They generally do clean-up work and tasks required to stop further damage from being done, e.g. putting tarps on damaged roofs. They might do minor repairs that help make homes habitable, but they do not do extensive repairs or reconstruction (that is the job for Long Term Recovery).

All members of an Early Response Team are required to complete the eight-hour training course and must have a current background check. The ERT training is done according to UMCOR guidelines and policies. The background check is completed prior to training through <u>Safe Gatherings/Trusted con Confianza training and certification process</u>. As long as your background check is current, you can attend the ERT training. If not, you can complete the training and background check by going to <u>www.riotexas.org/safesteps</u> before your ERT class. Persons completing the training and passing the background check are issued a badge indicating they are approved by the Rio Texas Conference and credentialed by UMCOR for three years. An Early Response Team is a special type of VIM Team.

An Early Response Team has a very narrow function and has no management or administrative responsibility for the overall disaster response. An "Early Response Team" should not be confused with a Disaster Recovery Team. An Early Response Team is a specially trained and certified team called to do early response. A Disaster Recovery Team is a type of UMVIM Team that comes to assist in the long-term recovery, AFTER early response is completed. Each Early Response Team member must be trained and carry an identification badge reissued by UMCOR following successful completion of Early Response Team Training.

ABOUT THE ERT TRAINING

Registration - 8:00 a.m. Training - 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

The class will cover the purpose of an Early Response Team:

- To show that the church cares about what has happened to the people,
- To assist the most vulnerable populations with their immediate needs, and
- To provide assistance that will help to prevent further damage to homes and property.

The class will also cover team member responsibilities, how to equip a team, how to prevent further damage (the four basic jobs), and more.

Training will be included for:


- Tarping, mucking/gutting, salvaging
- Tools/Equipment Set-up
- Team member safety
