CAMPER'S COVENANT OF BEHAVIOR

I (print name), _____, agree that I will follow required conduct standards that reflect the love of God and of others and that promote individual and group safety. If I should not act in accordance with this covenant while attending camp, I realize that I may be disciplined at the camp leader's discretion, up to expulsion from camp and suspension from future events.

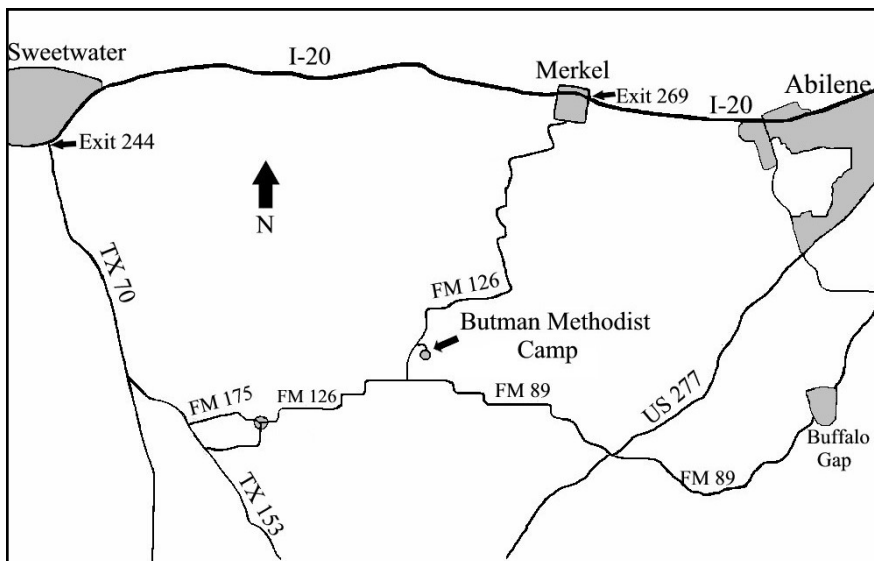
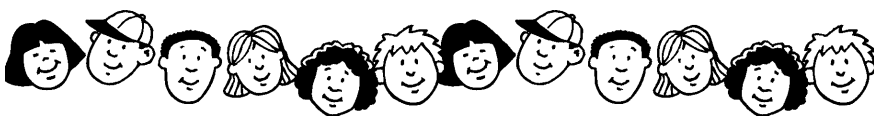
In preparation, campers should plan to pack the following:

- tennis shoes & flip flops (to wear to the pool)
- swimsuit (one-piece)
- cool, comfortable clothes that can get dirty
- rain jacket/gear
- sunscreen
- insect repellent
- toothpaste, toothbrush, soap, shampoo, and other personal toiletries
- pillow, blanket, bed linens for a twin bed (or sleeping bag)
- washcloth & bath and swimming towels
- flashlight
- Bible

For security and safety reasons, campers should leave at home expensive jewelry, large sums of money, and electronic devices.

At the same time, campers will not need to bring their own food. We will have three hearty meals per day and plenty of snacks, and we also want to also avoid insects in the cabins.

All medications must be checked in with the Camp Nurse at Registration. Medications, both prescription and over the counter, must be in the original bottle with specific instructions for use.
