This practice ensures open communication and honest sharing in the consultation process.

In cooperation with the SPRC chairperson, you need to call a meeting of the committee so they can complete the 2022-2023 Staff/Pastor-Parish Relations Consultation Form. I need their form no later than Thursday, December 1, 2022. Bishop Schnase has scheduled the Cabinet's inventory session for January 11-13, 2023. In order for me to best represent you and the churches of the Hill Country and West Districts, please make every effort to honor the deadline of December 1.
