RATES

Late Charge: A later charge of \$25.00 on unpaid balance subject to special conditions below.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 1. The balance is unpaid and subject to a late charge if the bill is past-due, or delinquent, as defined in Rule No. 11, Section B.1.a.
- 2. The late charge should be imposed on a delinquent bill since the account would be shut off before a subsequent bill and then subject to the reconnection fee as authorized by the Tariff Rule No. 11.
- 3. All bills shall be subject to the reimbursement fee as set forth on Schedule No. UF.
- 4. A customer taking Residential Service, whose household income is below 200 percent of the federal poverty level, is entitled to have late payment charges on delinquent bills waived once every twelve (12) months pursuant to Tariff Rule No. 11.B.1.a (3).
- 5. A late fee will be applied to any account that is not paid before the past due date shown on the bill. The fee shall be applied after the due date of the 24th of each month. The fee shall be assessed every other month on all open balances regardless of whether it is an initial or subsequent bill when a total balance has not been paid or there should have been a shut off for non-payment agreement. If a payment plan is agreed to and set up with the utility and the customer is current on such plan then the late fee(s) shall be suspended. (C)
