


OLD FIELDS pastor Rev. Larry Powers and member Chris Greene deliver a total of 560 items and \$280!

Winter Time

But there is also winter! While we might be able to relocate ourselves to a place where we can avoid the cold, there's no place that we can escape the winter of the soul. When you go through the winter of the soul, **cling tenaciously to the hope that is yours in Christ.** The Psalmist understood the power and reality of hope. He put it like this, *"Sorrow may last for a night, but joy comes in the morning." That's God's promise!* Faith helps you to do what you have to do. I spent a lot of time with the Bible and it reminded me to do the best that I could each day and to trust God for the future. God has a plan for our life! Trusting Him is a big part of it.
