"Pre-One Hundred Thirty - Fourth Annual Meeting of the Ashe Baptist Association"

The Executive Committee of the Ashe Baptist Association has approved unanimously to have a one-day Annual Meeting on Saturday, August 15 beginning at 9:00 AM and ending at approximately 12:00 with lunch provided. Beaver Creek Baptist Church, on the Mulatto Mountain Road, will be our host. They have a new Fellowship Hall with lots of room and will have picnic tables available if you want to eat outside. Rev. Johnny Goodman is the pastor. The Executive Committee recommends only two folks from each church attend, pastor and one representative. This is a one time exception from our constitution due to COVID-19. The Friday session will not be held due to COVID-19. Hopefully next year we will be back on track. As always, COVID-19 recommendations will be in place so as to remain as healthy as possible. I think we all have the 3-W's memorized, wear a mask, wait six feet and wash your hands often. If you are scheduled to attend that day and are not feeling well please stay at home, for your safety and the safety of others, and send someone in your place. We understand. Masks are optional inside the church especially if you are observing social distancing. We currently have 16 active cases of COVID-19 in Ashe County out of 27,000 folks at the time of this writing. That is not bad but we would like to see that number even lower. Please pray for those affected. If you have questions or concerns please let us know. Our theme this year is "We are in This Together". Our text is; 1 Corinthians 3:9 which shares with us, "For we are laborers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building". Our front cover shows two men mowing with a horse drawn mowing machine working together getting the job of mowing hay done "together." I remember those days when my Dad and I and neighbors worked together to get hay ready to feed during the winter time. As Ashe Baptist Association of Churches works together, we are to be about the Father's business. We must work with everyone who will join in for the cause of Christ working together doing what we cannot do alone. I try to work with all denominations, because if they know Christ they are my brother/sister. I even work with folks who are not Christians in an effort to promote the cause of Christ and hope that "lifestyle evangelism" will lead them to the Saviour! COVID-19 challenges us to work even harder and not give up as some folks have. At the Annual meeting Rev. Homer Murdock is scheduled to bring our message with Rev. Lawrence Goodman as the alternate. We have scheduled reports from Ashe Really Cares, Disciple Making, the Treasurer, Budget Chairman, Ashe Baptist Campground committee, Guidestone, Ashe Pregnancy Care Center, Historian Report, Baptist Men, Director of Missions and Gideons International. Also included will be presentations of accomplishments of churches and our Memorial Service. Other reports may be added that I do not have at this time. Business will be conducted as needed. Our Moderator will be Mr. Jerry Powers and our Vice Moderator will be Mr. Joe Brown. I hope that you will pray for the Annual Meeting and plan to attend if you are chosen by the church where you are a member. I feel we will be safe and look forward to God's Holy Spirit speaking to me about the fact that "we are in this together!" If you come, I will buy your lunch that day! After all, we are in this together.

As we continue to work through our current situation with this Covid-19, we look toward the one who is in charge. The one who made the heavens and the earth. The one who watches over his children. Let us not be looking toward our world for an answer but to the one who holds our future.

Things have been going good with our neighbors coming in to shop for themselves. They are respecting the new rules that are in place. They are understanding that this is for their safety and for ours. If some of the neighbors still don't feel comfortable coming in or wearing a mask we are able to prepare the food box for them and take it to their car.

Last month we were able to serve 124 families which touched 252 individuals. We had 3 new families to come in needing assistance. Our numbers are a little low which is probably due to the amount of food stamps that they are receiving due to Covid. I look for the number to increase after the extra money is gone.

The food we receive from Second Harvest Food Bank has been low on their salvage items along with some of their TEFAP (government bought food). Ashe County Cooperative Extension brought us five pallets of food so that it would help stock our shelves. The churches have been bringing by the items they have collected so that helps a lot. Some of the items we are low on are: Jiffy Cornbread Mix, can potatoes, can pinto beans, can tomatoes, can carrots and sauerkraut. We appreciate everything that you do to help support the ARC. Please continue to pray for those we serve.

Remember your garden items if you have extra and would like to share with our neighbors.



WHY IS THE FOOD ROUNDUP SO VITAL?


The Food Roundup in April had to be postponed because of COVID-19. As a result, our pantry shelves in our children's cottages are becoming bare.

Discipleship Tip of the Month

"The Many Faces of Sin" (Genesis 3)

Unbelief, pride, lust, disobedience, fear and self justification are still with us. Sin may take many faces and shapes but essentially it is the same today as in the Garden of Eden. It came into the world in the person of the serpent. Adam and Eve had no experience in sin, but their six experiences as here indicate the major shapes of sin for all time. The woman believed the serpent instead of God. Some theologians believe that pride is the basic sin from which all other sins flow. Adam said, I was afraid, because I was naked and I hid myself. Adam blamed Eve, Eve blamed the serpent. God put a curse on the serpent, then on Eve, then on Adam. The Bible teaches that all have sinned and come short of the glory of God. Jesus came that our sins might be forgiven and that we can know God in a personal relationship. (1John 1:9)
