"The Ashe County Children's Christmas Project 2020"

Thank you Ashe County and beyond for all the help with the Ashe County Children's Christmas Project! A few months ago I met with twenty different groups from Ashe County concerning the Christmas Project. With COVID-19 going on I did not know if we could serve up to one thousand children again this year. After some discussion they voted unanimously to move forward. I was very thankful that we, as God's people could have the opportunity to touch the lives of children, young people, as well as adults allowing to show the love that Jesus has taught us to share. Its one thing to say you love someone but when there is action involved it speaks volumes! Our young folks are going through a hard time dealing with COVID-19. We need to help them enjoy Christmas and the love that Jesus give us. When the least of these are left out, it is a sad situation. They cannot help the situation they are in, for they are children and young people in a grown up world. This love from folks goes beyond the children to young people and to adults as well. It is a time of giving and sharing. Helping those who cannot help their situation due to circumstances that they are caught up in. Folks need to know that God loves them and people from Ashe County and beyond love them as well. Together we have made this happen for many years and I for one am very thankful. Thank you Department of Social Services, Partnership of Ashe, Cooperative Extension, Parks and Recreation, Family Central, each School, Library, all the Industry (thank you GE Aviation who took 100 names), WKSK Radio, County of Ashe and lots of Churches as well as individuals. Together we make this happen. God is so good to lead and guide us to share the love of Jesus. This year we are working with 900 children and at the time of this writing we have 44 names left. Hopefully they will all be taken in the next few days. This year no wrapping or checking due to COVID-19. We are trying to be as safe as possible for the children, parents, donors and workers. Gifts will be bagged and tagged beginning November 30 through December 4 at Family Central in the Common Area (old cafeteria). They will be transported to storage and then on Monday, December 7 beginning at 8:00 we will move them to the gym for distribution. **WE NEED HELP MOVING THOSE BAGS!** We will also be moving 877 back packs from the churches in Stanley Association for distribution as well. Thank you Stanley Association. We will be wearing masks and following guidelines to keep us healthy. It is better to give than to receive. We have the opportunity to give gifts, time, money, labor and love as Christ would have us to. This makes Christmas for me and it can for you as well! Seeing the happiness on the faces of folks in need makes my day. Some folks work very hard but still cannot make it ,so we can help them and share some love with them. Our volunteers have a happy face as well! Seeing folks from all walks of life come together makes me glad to be from the coolest corner of North Carolina, Ashe County. It's a little bit of Heaven on earth to see folks working together for a common cause that they believe in especially with COVID-19 going on. We need joy in our lives and the Christmas Project gives this to everyone who helps. Joy unlocks a sense of purpose and hope which ultimately, with the Lord's Blessings helps all. For God's children, the power of joy is never-ending. Although not one fruit of the spirit is more important than another, joy enables us to experience the other fruit in the way that Jesus did. **Merry Christmas to everyone!**

The Ashe County Volunteer Initiative Program has now begun its Annual Canned Food Drive, which will run through December 4th. Each year the Volunteer Initiative places boxes at drop off locations where the community can donate canned food and non-perishable items for those Ashe County families in need. Once the donations are collected, they are dispensed among our four local food banks. These are: Ashe Really Cares, The Sharing Center, A Safe Home for Everyone, and Ashe Outreach Ministries. This year will be different due to COVID-19. We are asking for monetary donations only, to stop the spread of the virus.

It is difficult to comprehend, but in our nation, one in six people is hungry, one in five children are hungry, 50 million Americans are hungry. Likewise, about one in every five North Carolinians is hungry and will not have access to enough food this year. That includes over one in every four children in our state. Many of these individuals are going hungry because they have to choose between paying rent and utilities and buying food. This is a wonderful opportunity to make a difference in the lives of many families in our county, not only during the holidays, but throughout the year.

The Practical Side Of Being A Pastor

Drs. Harold and Laila Bare

Missionary Ambassadors Ministering To Pastors' Families

Age 27 Laila and I accepted responsibility for a Southwest Virginia congregation of 17 people. The entire property was about 75' x 75' with a one-room 24' x 36' cinderblock building serving all congregational purposes. No parking lot. No restrooms. No classrooms.

Adding to the sense of hopelessness the tiny and ugly building was located on the last side of the town to get modern plumbing. The neighborhood was stigmatized.

We were determined to make a difference. I searched the records for anyone who was alive that had previously attended. Young and energetic we reached out to the community with minimal results. We were treated respectfully in public, but our church family remained small.

One Saturday I visited fifty-three people. It was a long, tiring, wonderful day of being well-received. I was optimistic for increased attendance on Sunday. It did not happen. I was very disappointed, not angry with God, but curious as to the failed venture of visitation.

I had a revelation: The church building needed a facelift. Time for a hiatus. I visited only the sick, elderly or troubled for months.

Friends and family from a previous church we had attended took time from work, brought tools and traveled hundreds of miles to come and help remodel the sanctuary and open up restrooms.

New folks came.

I had learned a powerful lesson. Folks have little respect for a pastor or congregation if the place of worship is not presentable. There was further progress when we purchased land and built a first-phase sanctuary on property across from the community golf course.

Lesson Number Two took more time.

I was sure that preaching powerful sermons with lots of scripture would result in a healthy body of believers who would evangelize and bring new converts to join our family. I was wrong.

It took time for me to grasp that Joseph was in school in Potiphar's house and the king's prison. Moses mentored Joshua. Elijah mentored Elisha. There were schools of prophets in the Old Testament. Jesus made disciples ("...and his disciples came to him...and he taught them" Matthew 5). Paul mentored, encouraged and held accountable Timothy, Titus, John Mark, et al.

Only when I came to understand that sermons must include instruction for *making disciples* did ministry become truly fulfilling with gratifying results.

Teaching skills is far more difficult than constructing a sermon expounding on a theme. Developing leaders is hard work. Trial and error. Teaching. On-the-job training. Prayer. Patience. Accountability. Expertise. More work out of the pulpit than in it!

Bible lessons taught in small groups must be consistent with the Sunday morning message. Strategy to build leaders must be developed with intention.

Healthy congregations are a result of team-building. Every leader is important and skilled. Independency is surrendered in unity.

Our Lord struggled often with disciples closest to him. However, there came a day when He called them friends.

Having faithful souls gather regularly for repeated worship events has little value if discipleship is not the driving motif.

When a pastor can count disciples that have been matured to become leaders there is a joy that cannot be measured! There is a reward that is heavenly and eternal.

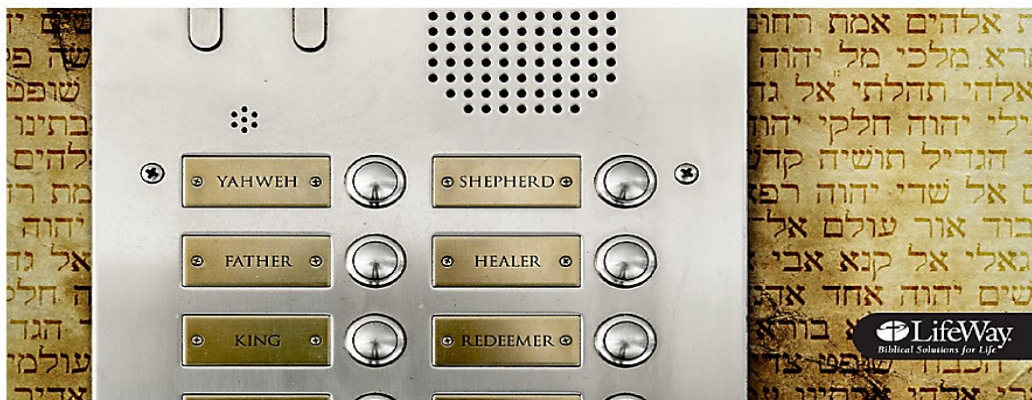
