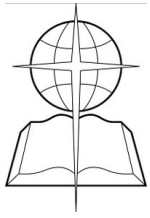

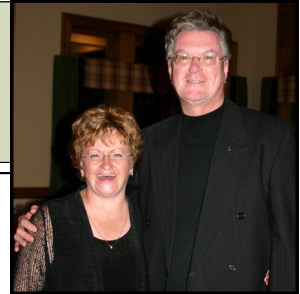

### "Post comments from 133rd Annual Meeting of the Ashe Baptist Association"

Twenty-two years since I have been the Director of Mission, these two days of the Association were the most wonderful that I have ever attended. For those who wanted revival, they got it! God's Spirit was very much magnified in these meetings. Thank you to all the presenters and all who attended. We had a lady who was 94 years old attending from Obids Baptist Church. Thank you Mrs. Margret Watson! It was well attended by the churches and visitors as well. Both churches were full each day. Thank you Welcome Home Baptist Church and Big Flatts Baptist Church for hosting and especially the meals! Beautiful, brand new fellowship Hall at Big Flatts Baptist Church was ready for the church to serve us. Thank you Mr. David Phillips and Mrs. Kathy Bower for leading our music. Our special music was wonderful, Jeff Matheson and Mrs. Janet Houck, Rev. Billy Norris and his Mom, Betty Triplett and The Vessels of Grace blessed our hearts. Special thanks to our ministers who brought the word of God alive for us; the Reverends Lonnie Carpenter, Alan Ambrose, Billy Norris and Teddy Shatley. Thank you moderators Brother Jerry Powers and Rev. Michael Carter. Many tears were shed, testimonies given and reports of many being saved and coming to know Jesus as Lord and Savior! There was lots of praying especially in the altar. Lots of references were given about our theme "No Place Left" from Matthew 24:14. We will not quit until there is no place left that the gospel of Jesus Christ has not been shared! The salvation of souls and the Discipling of our Christians rang out all through the meeting by Baptist State Convention folks and our Ashe Baptist Folks. Ninety-five percent of our folks who do not attend convention meetings got to hear nine convention leaders talk about the work of Southern Baptists. Dr. Milton Holifield, Executive Director / Treasurer of the Baptist State Convention of NC, gave an excellent update on lots of work that is going on in NC and abroad. There are four thousand three hundred churches in the Baptist State Convention of NC. At the NC Baptist Assembly at Fort Caswell this year 277 churches visited and 430 were saved, 123 called to ministry, 285,000 meals packed for Haiti and \$70,000 dollars given for the work of Christ. Sixty-nine churches speak a different language in NC, one thousand one hundred and sixty nine folks were saved. God is at work in NC and you are His arms and legs to do the work. Our local committee heads gave sixteen reports of the work in the Ashe Baptist Association. Thank you Ashe Baptist Churches for all the work you do for the cause of Christ. A High Country Prayer Journey with a charter bus was introduced which will allow 50 some folks to ride the bus all through Ashe County and pray for needs and for salvation of the sixty percent of folks who are not saved. If you want to join us call the office for more information. Also an Awakening Rally is being held at Midway Baptist Church on September 8-9-10 and you are invited to come so we can work together to obey the command of Jesus in His last words to the church, teach others what we know so God can save the lost and revive the church, for His glory and Him to be revealed in a watching world that needs to know Him. We are most thankful that during business time a new church, Appalachian, joined the Association. Pastor Steve Ashley has a heart for God and wants to work together for the kingdom's uplifting. Thank you Myra Phillips, Pat Miller, Shelia Miller, Diane Dixon and Linda Blackburn who gave out packets of materials and name tags. Most of all we praise God for His touching us by magnifying His Holy Spirit within us! The most tears I have seen in twenty two years of annual meetings were shed. Hands raised and shouts of men and women were seen every where. May it continue all through the churches and our land as a mighty force of rushing water and pray many will come to know Christ and be discipled!! May you be a part of the movement until there is "No Place Left" to share the gospel!

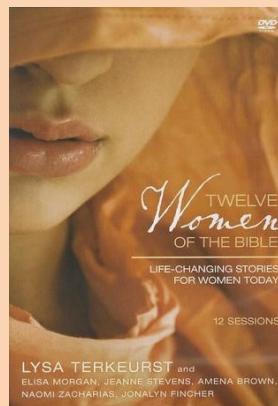

On Friday, in addition to all the reports presented by reps from various ministries that we support through the Baptist State Convention, we were honored to have **Milton and Gloria Hollifield** with us. Milton serves as the Executive Director/ Treasurer of the NCBSC. He referenced his 'Ministry Highlights' publication and spoke about 1) 2019 Youth Camps at Caswell, where 430 youth were saved and 123 felt the call to ministry; 2) "Collegiate Partnerships" spanning 45 campuses in NC with 378 salvations; and 3) Great Commission Partnerships; engaging the unreached people groups in NC. He announced Baptism Sunday is Sept 8th, and referenced Psalm 78:3-7 to emphasize the importance of "Family Evangelism".

***"By God's grace we will become the strongest force in the history of this convention for reaching people with the message of the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ."***

Saturday's meeting at Big Flatts Baptist Church, focused on local ministries and missions of the Ashe Missionary Baptist Association. Speakers representing those gave reports on their last year of service.

Rev. Teddy Shatley gave the message citing the three times in scripture that Jesus wept.

Rev. Michael Carter served as Moderator.

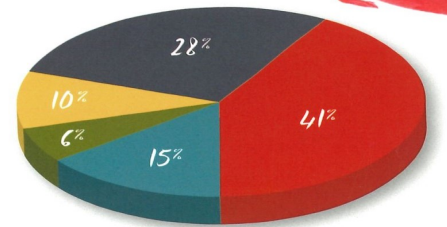

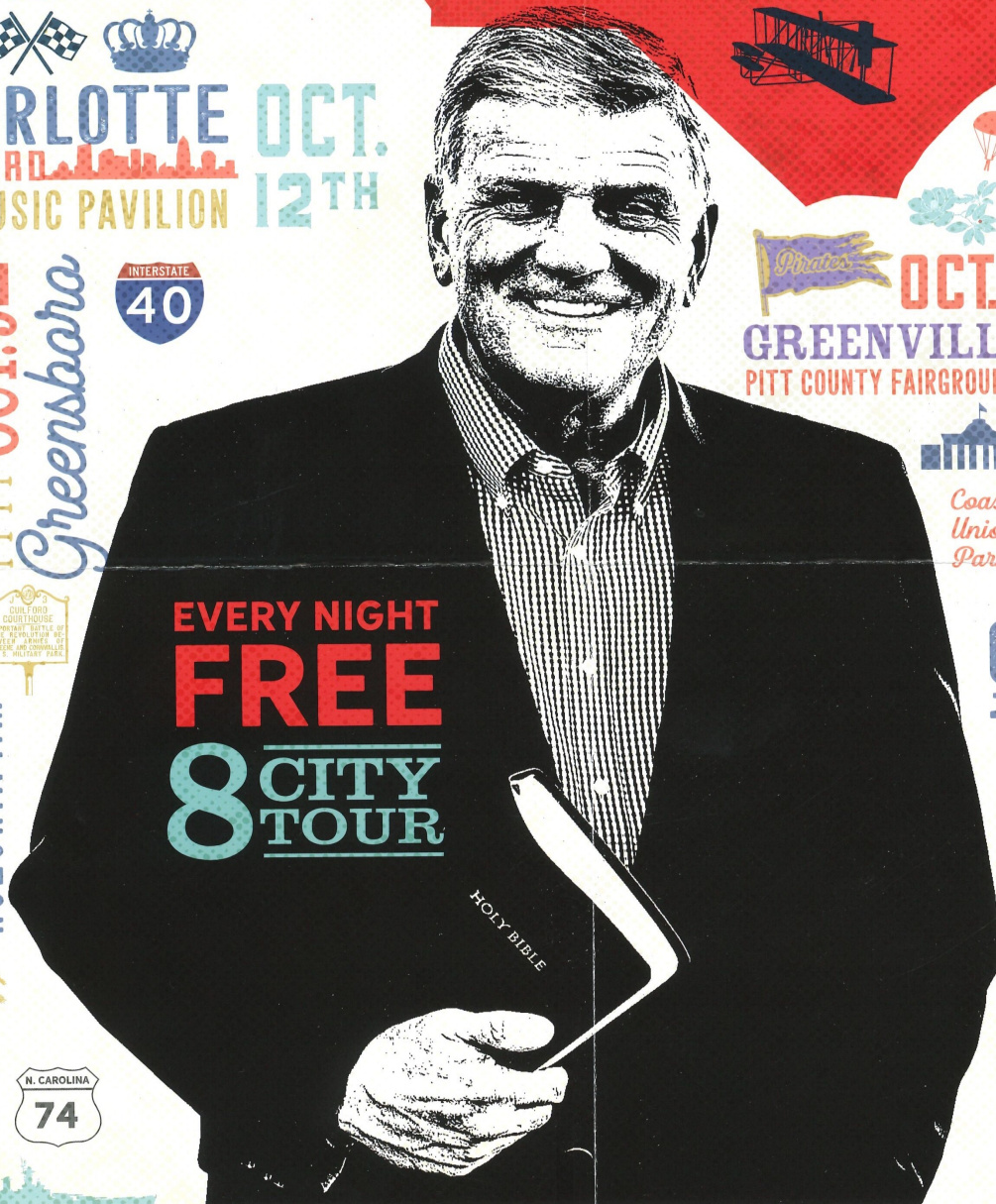

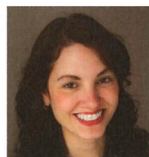

## Discipleship Thought of the Month

### Fall is upon us!

Like all seasons, the season of fall is marked by profound changes. Autumn winds break the summer heat and provide a pleasant coolness across most of the world. Leaves change their hues in lovely bursts of color, then fall gently to the ground. The sun begins its annual retreat, bringing less and less light to each new day. While the autumn leaves are certainly lovely in a decorative sense, they're also lifeless and unproductive. The fall is often a season of waiting -- waiting for winter, waiting for the holidays, waiting for the Super Bowl, and so on.

The apostle James captured this theme with a farming metaphor to remind us of the importance of waiting on God's timing. Consider passages from God's Word as you enjoy the blessings of autumn. Because even in a season of great change, the Scriptures remain a firm foundation for life.
