"Post Ashe County Children's Christmas Project 2020"

The Ashe County Children's Christmas Project 2020 is concluded for this year. We want to thank everyone who made it possible for 900 children to have a great Christmas. There are a lot of good people in Ashe County and beyond. We have folks from outside the county who help us and we appreciate it as well. I will not try to mention all the names because I will miss someone, but you know who you are. Some folks took a hundred names or more and some folks took one name. All are important and God blessed those gifts, the children and their parents. There was prayer for them many times in the process. Jesus said it is better to give than to receive and these folks have learned that passage in their lives. Thank you so much, to God be the glory. From the lady who had cancer and taking chemo and hands swollen too much to carry the bags of gifts, to the Father who had Covid, to the child who had Covid, so much sorrow and pain. There was the couple who lost their jobs because of Covid, the Grandparents who are raising the family, to those in Foster Care and the list goes on. Together we have found a way to help them in the name of Jesus! They all say thank you and I do too! I did not know if we would be able to have this project this year because of COVID-19. We met with twenty different groups in the summer and they all said lets try to make it happen. The children are depending on us! Folks began to pray and to work to make it happen. God blessed us as only He can and He made it happen. Many of you were the hands and feet of God! We did not wrap the gifts this year at Family Central because of COVID we just received them and bagged and carried them to storage. Later that week we moved them to the gym at Ashe County Parks and Recreation at Family Central and placed them in numerical order in rows of hundreds. Volunteers worked all week to move and insure that the gifts were in order. Folks from all walks of life came. It was a little bit of heaven on earth. A glimpse of how it will be in heaven one day! Face coverings were worn and safety measures were put in place. The usual COVID recommendations were adhered to. Temperatures were taken of everyone who entered the gym on pickup day. Over 500 people came that day to pick up gifts for 900 children. 30 volunteers from Stanley Baptist Association east of Charlotte, NC came and distributed 875 back packs filled with Christmas goodies, clothing and school supplies, all graded by age and sex and were given to each child in the family as we gave the bagged gifts to the children. As far we know, no one got COVID that week due to God's mercy at the Ashe County Children's Christmas Project! It takes a lot of folks from Ashe County and beyond to make this happen. Businesses, churches, organizations, groups, individuals work together with God's blessings to help make Ashe County the coolest corner in North Carolina. I'm glad to be a part of the community, trying to make it a better place to live. Together we can and do accomplish great things for God and His children. If you were not able to help this year perhaps you will again have the opportunity to help next year and be blessed as we were this past year. II Corinthians 9:7 "Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver". Hebrews 13:16 "But to do good and to communicate forget not: for with such sacrifices God is well pleased". James 1:17 "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning". May we be a giver of gifts all year and be reminded it not about us, it about God and others. What a wonderful God we serve! We are a blessed people, may we share with those who are less fortunate that they make know that there is a God in heaven that loves them and people in Ashe County and beyond that loves them too!

God has blessed us to have seen another year come and go. It has been a challenging year no doubt but we have also seen the hand of God at work. As last year began and the COVID virus came into play we have seen many changes. We have had to adapt into things that maybe we don't like. Even through all of the chaos, we as God's children know who is still in control.

The changes that have been made at the ARC has helped to keep not only the staff safe but our neighbors as well. When food got low we were amazed how God's people brought in food and money donations to help. We have been blessed with items so that we could make sure that families were fed. Last month we serve 113 families which touched 249 Individuals. With the clothing we touched 136 families. We also had 5 new families come in needing assistance. Through the Appalachian Senior Program we were able to help 15 of our senior adults for Christmas. Each one received a bag full of gifts, a box of food and each one had \$300 paid on their electric bill for the winter. The thankfulness on their faces puts a smile on our hearts. Thank you Appalachian Senior Program!!!

As we look to what God has in store for this year, let us always remember to share Christ with those around us. Sometimes it is as simple as a smile(even though it's hard to see the smile under our mask). Keep believing, trusting and sharing God's love and his son Jesus Christ.

Remember that Souper Bowl Sunday is coming up soon. We encourage the churches to announce our Souper Bowl Collection. Last year we collected over 8,000 items. We run the collection through the end of February (due to sometimes bad weather). The total collected will be given out at that time. Thank you for engaging in this project, it is our big push for items which last us several months.

Thank you and your church for all of the support that you give to the ARC. With your help and God's guidance we can make a difference in the lives of those you are in need.

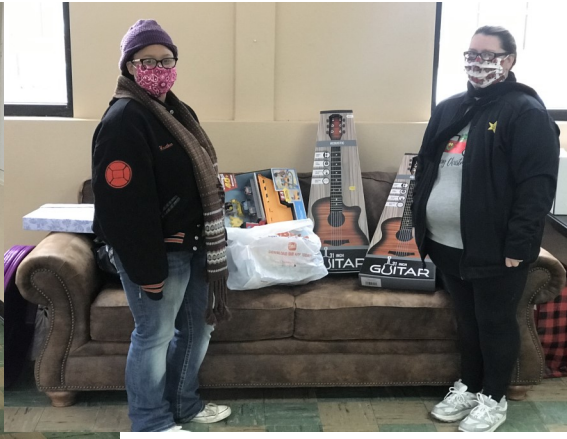

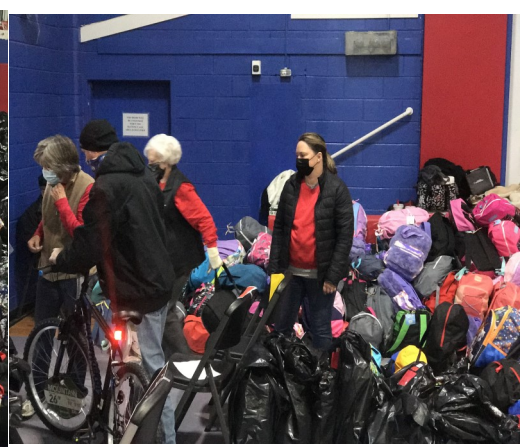

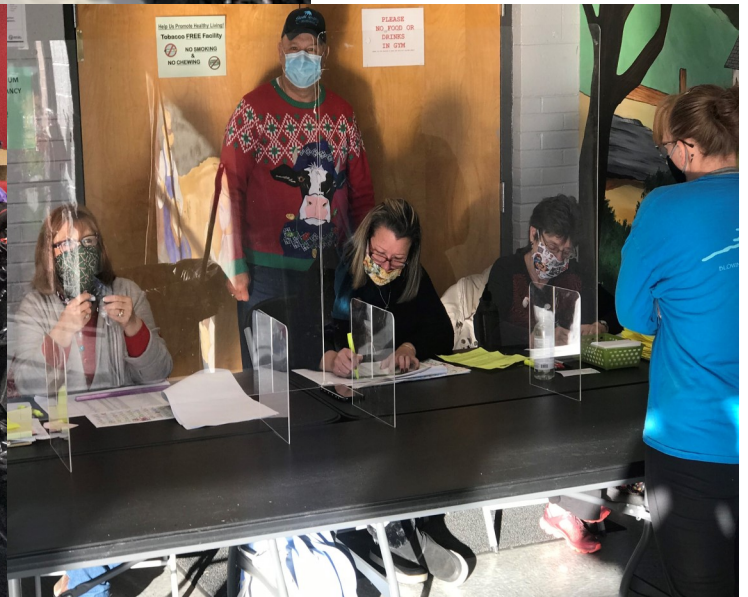
Ashe County Christmas Project

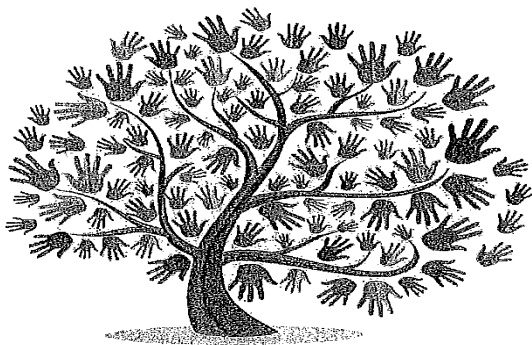
Dear Friends,

Ebenezer Christian Children's Home started with a group of concerned Christians who saw the need for quality, safe places for children in foster care in the early 1990's. God has grown the ministry beyond what anyone could have imagined. Now, we are beginning to see our children's homes cropping up everywhere like kingdom trees, providing shelter and care for children in need. We continue to sow with great expectations in new territory to help little ones who do not yet have a safe place to laugh, play, and dream.

We are excited to share our expansion news! We have been blessed with the donation of two tracts of land and feel lead by the Lord to create new safe spaces for children in your community. One home will be built in Hudson, and the other in Old Fort. Ebenezer is truly **a mission in your own back yard**, serving children in need from your community. The children we serve are in DSS custody, due to abuse or neglect. What makes Ebenezer different from other congregate care options for foster children is our commitment to teach the truth of the Gospel of Jesus Christ while offering total care. The need for foster care continues to grow in our communities, and providing total care—not just a bed and meals, but support for children's mental, physical, academic, and spiritual needs—is no easy task.

We have been heavily impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, as it has hindered our ability to do in-person fundraisers that enable our Non-Profit organization to continue our mission. And yet, we are talking about *expanding*, purely because of our *trust in the Lord*, His love and care for the fatherless. We submit to his leadership, and His blessing alone makes us able to compete our mission.

We will be hosting a "Share-A-Thon" on February 27, this event will be broadcast live on Facebook, YouTube, and our website www.EbenezerFamily.org. The event will feature testimonies from members of our Ebenezer Family, which includes staff, foster families, adoptive families, and former resident children we have served, and we will also share what great things God is doing even now through this ministry.



This year's theme is "See a Need, Plant a Seed," because we have seen what amazing things God can do when His people are willing to trust Him with mustard seed faith. We are reaching out to invite your church to partner with us to expand this ministry by calling on church members to sow whatever they are able in faith that God will do much with little for children in need. We ask that you begin today through joining us in prayer, and we would encourage you to consider taking up a love offering as well to be given on the day of our fundraiser.

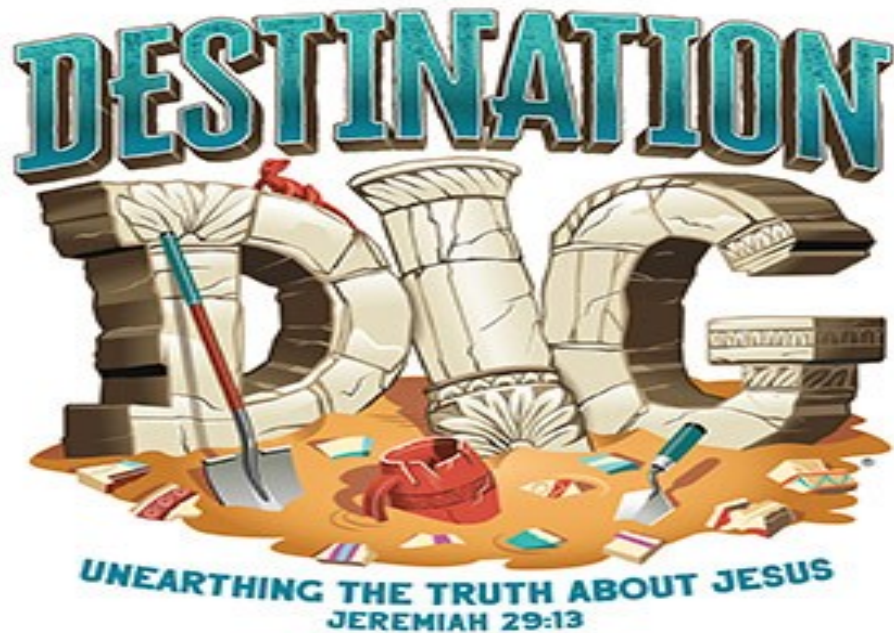

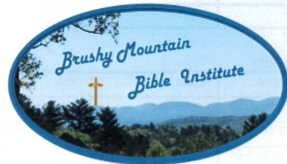

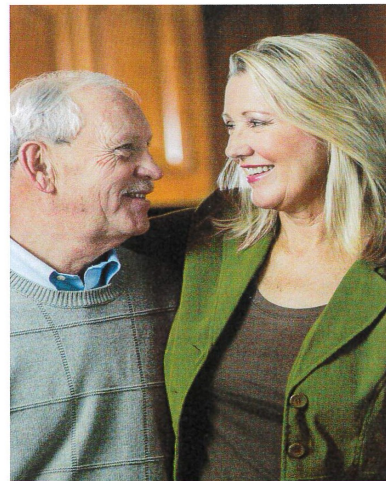
