

"Post Ashe County Children's Christmas Project 2022"

It was a big success to say the least! To God be the glory. I appreciate all the folks who made it possible. From all the churches, individuals who took red cards, businesses, industry, DSS, Cooperative Extension, Partnership of Ashe, WKSK Radio, Parks and Rec. Randy Marion Ford of Ashe County, Santa, West Jefferson Police Dept, baggers, runners, those who put the bicycles together, Gideons International of Ashe County, folks who gave money and all those I have left out we thank you from the bottom of my heart. This is community effort, everyone working together for the cause of Christ. It's a little bit of heaven, folks of all denominations working together. Lots of Christian witness has been done because of you. You are the arms and feet of Jesus. Prayer was offered at different times for the children and their parents. Many Bibles went out to everyone. We did our best to help 770 children have a great Christmas with gifts, backpacks and love. We sent 300 or more fully loaded backpacks to the flood victims in Kentucky with 50 bicycles and some extra toys and clothes by way of Warrensville Baptist Church who have been there 5 times in the last little while. Approximately 500 Bibles were distributed by the Gideons International of Ashe. Three different sets of folks came at different times to witness to all who came that day. From beginning at 8:00 and at 5:00 when we finished. Helping folks of Ashe County who live in poverty is a priority for me. Because of sickness, disaster, family problems, debt and many other problems folks have a hard time especially at Christmas. Most all work but do not make enough money to enjoy the pleasures of life. When children return back to school after Christmas and their friends say what they got for Christmas it is my goal that all children receive something that they can talk about and not be burdened by the fact that they did not get anything. Nothing is sadder than a child that did not get a gift at Christmas. I believe that missions begins at home and then we spread out to North Carolina, United States and the world. That's the reason that I'm a Southern Baptist in denomination because of the witness that we do around the world and at home. The gift of folks receiving Christ as Savior is a priority for me. Christmas is a great time to share the love of Jesus and share what he has done for each of us. Lifestyle evangelism and direct talk to folks are good ways of leading folks to Christ. I still believe the word of God, the Bible and the Holy Spirit are required for folks to be saved. We can share the word in many ways but God is the one who eventually saves all of us. It's not about us, its all about God and his plan for us. I want to promote God and Him alone! 
2022 ABA Pastor, Wife and Staff Christmas Dinner






