Our Book of Reports Cover picture was taken by Mr. Ed Reed of the Warrensville Baptist Church. The butterfly blossomed in to something beautiful from a worm and that is **encouraging** to all of us. God can change us into an **encouraged** person if we will let Him work in our life. May this be the year that you become positive and do away with negative thoughts and actions. Now, if we've been paying attention in Sunday School over the years, we might remember that Barnabas traveled with Paul during many of his missionary journeys. But what we might not remember, is that Barnabas' real name was "Joseph." The early apostles just decided to call him "Barnabas"-which means "son of encouragement"—when he sold a field that he owned and brought the money to the leaders of the church so they could distribute it to those who had need (see Acts 4:36-37). And for the rest of the Book of Acts, whenever we hear about Barnabas doing something-especially on his own-it usually has to do with helping somebody else. In Acts Chapter 9, for example, Barnabas is one who brings Paul into the fellowship of the disciples after Paul saw Jesus on the road to Damascus. And in Acts Chapter 15, it's Barnabas who decides to give a second chance to a young Christian named Mark, who eventually went on to write one of the gospels. And the extraordinary thing about Saint Barnabas, I think, is that what he did to earn his reputation is the kind of stuff that anyone could do! We might not think of ourselves as being "saints." But we could give, and provide a welcome, and offer second chances. And who knows? Maybe someday we could be remembered as "sons and daughters of encouragement."




