Is the Spirit of God Living in You?

Galatians 5:22 shares with us: But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, v.23 - Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. V.24 - And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts.V.25 If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. Healthy things grow and when spiritual children deepen their connection to God and a family church, they naturally mature and grow. The Holy Spirit works in our lives as we begin to understand the biblical truths through our devotional time and prayer. Life in the Spirit is so vital to us all. We know when God is talking to us and revealing things to us because His Spirit lives with in us. 1 Corinthians 3:16 shares with us; Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you? Verse 17 shares; If any man defile the temple of God, Him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which temple ye are. We can and should allow the Holy Spirit to help us exercise our freedom of choice by using the spiritual practices of study the scripture, personal prayer, and meditation, listening to the counsel of family of faith both past and present and our own reasoning abilities and experiences. Galatians 5:16 shares ; This I say then, Walk in the Spirit and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. When we believed in the Gospel and trusted Jesus to save us, then we were sealed with the Holy Spirit. If you are a believer then the Bible calls you God's temple because God's Spirit dwells within you. As children of God we literally have the Spirit of God living inside of us. Acts 1:8 shares with us ; But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about Jesus everywhere— In Jerusalem, through Judea, in Samaria and to the ends of the earth. This power that comes from the Holy Spirit allows you to stand strong for the things of God. Life in the Spirit urges us too love out neighbor, help to restore those who need to be Spiritual, and to bare one another burdens. We need to find folks who are plugged into the Spirit and spend time with them. The Bible shares where two or three are gathered together in My name there am I in the mist of them. Hebrews 10: 24-25 teaches to not forsake the assembling of ourselves together as the manor of some do but to consider one another unto love and to good works. Be a people of the Spirit! Jesus promised that the Spirit would be an Advocate who helps us, instructs us, reminds us of God's Word, testifies of Jesus, guides us into all truth, glorifies Christ, and empowers us to spread the gospel (John 14:16,26; 15:26; 16:13,14; Acts 1:8). The Spirit walks with us. The word that John uses to describe the Holy Spirit is parakletos or "paraclete." It means advocate, helper, intercessor, counselor — or one who comes alongside. I don't think it's a stretch to describe the Holy Spirit as a personal coach. He moves with us to direct our lives, bringing us closer to Jesus and making us more like Him. A Spirit-led church will focus on the Word of God transforming minds and permeating lives, by changing the way people think and live. That means we rely on the Spirit living with us and walking with us — not only to help us live holy lives but also to share Christ with a lost and dying world. The message of Christ delivered by people full of Spirit-empowered courage is what will change hearts. Is it possible that we have redefined the Pentecostal experience into a worship style instead of a lifestyle of mission? If so, we've lost our foundation. The Holy Spirit intentionally dwells within us to empower us to do missions so that people can know Christ! Be a people of the Spirit!

Last month we were able to serve 101 families with our food boxes which touched 209 individuals. We had 3 new families to come in needing assistance. We also helped 155 families with clothing and household items. A lot of items go out our doors each day and we are so blessed that you, the churches and our community are such giving people. As it begins to get warmer and some of us think of planting gardens, remember to plant a row of some type of vegetable to share with the ARC. We would love to be able to help our families to have nutritious food to go along with the food boxes.

We are in desperate need of some men to help us with our Food Lion Pickups on Wednesdays and Thursdays. Second Harvest also delivers on Wednesdays and if you don't want to be certified for that pickup but would just like to help off and on for the next few months please call. We have several men out right now who are sick and unable to pick up. This is causing a issue and making it very hard for us to get the food to the ARC without having to burden those who are picking up. Please pray about this and give me a call.

Without our volunteers we would not be able to meet the needs of our neighbors when they come in seeking help. Remember the seeds we sow have the opportunity to grow into salvation and eternity with God.

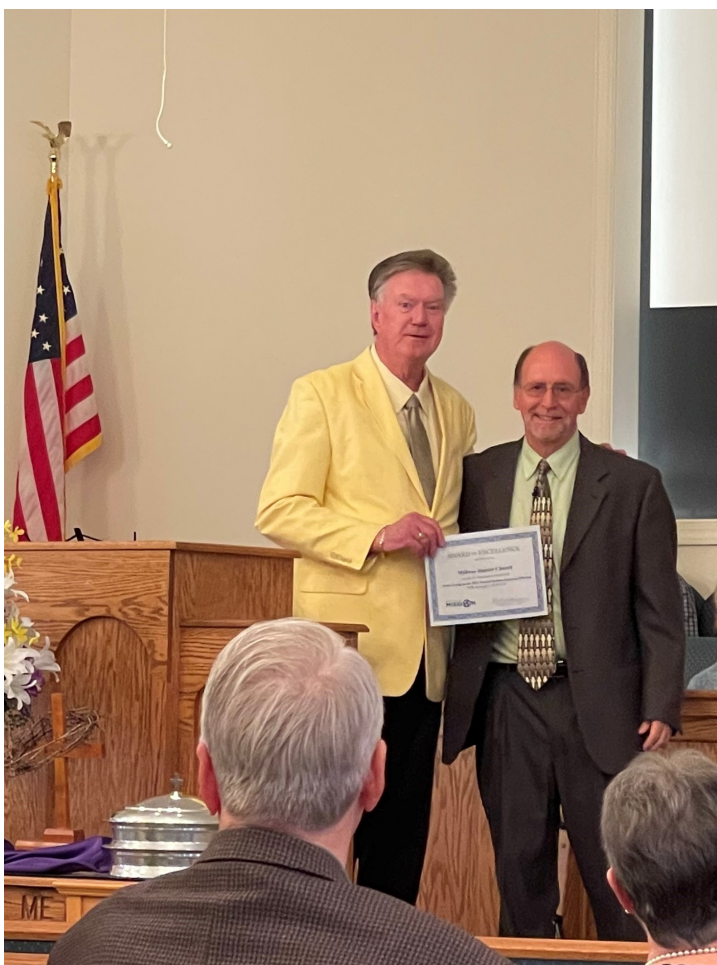

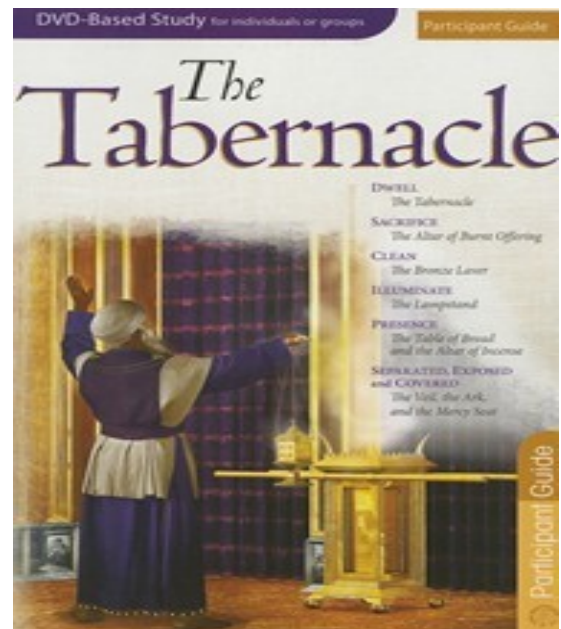

Ashe Community Paramedic Program is a 501-C nonprofit started with Cody Darnel through a grant by the Duke Endowment. The mission of the Ashe Community Paramedic Program is to bridge the gap between chronic health issues and the need for the emergency room. The Community Paramedic Program is made up of Paramedics from the Ashe County area and social work interns from Appalachian State University. The most important thing to remember when considering reaching out to the Ashe Community Paramedic Program is that they do not charge for any services or bill any insurance. The only requirement to receive help is that you live in Ashe County. Issues that the nonprofit helps with a range from issues impacting your physical health to concerns with mental health. To contact this organization you can call (336)620-0111 and speak with someone or leave a message and they will get back to you as soon as possible.
