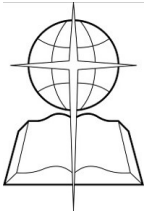

M-F 9AM-3PM after September 28. We have materials for all households in Ashe County and beyond and there is no cost for you. Hopefully we can canvas Ashe County and beyond in October before cold weather gets here. You will have zip codes and road maps to help you in your church area. Prayer walking your community and sharing with everyone is encouraged. There are 12,000 homes in Ashe County and Jesus died for all the folks who live there. I want to see them all know Jesus as their Savior and I know you do to. What did Paul mean when he said that he became all things to all men? 1 Corinthians 9:19: "For though I am free from all men, I have made myself a servant to all, that I might win the more (v.20) and to the Jews I became as a Jew, that I might win Jews; to those who are under the law, as under the law, that I might win those who are under the law (v.21) to those who are without law, as without law (not being without law toward God, but under law toward Christ), that I might win those who are without law (v.22) to the weak I became as weak, that I might win the weak. I have become all things to all men, that I might by all means save some. (v.23) Now this I do for the gospel's sake, that I may be partaker of it with you." In order to be successful we must take Jesus into the community. Do you know if you will go to heaven and live with the Father when you die? We encourage you to read the booklet and watch the video you receive, it will help you to understand how you can make that decision. Feel free to call us. Some of the items needed are: can sauerkraut, can pasta, Jiffy cornmeal mix, can tomatoes, We appreciate the churches and individuals who support and pray for the ARC. Your donations help to keep your mission going and your prayers help those who work at the ARC to keep sharing God's love. Thank you for your love and support as we work together.

Fall is here and we are beginning to see the changes in the colors of the leaves, but there are also other changes taken place. One of those changes is how the Faith Health ministry is beginning to change since Atrium has purchased NC Baptist Hospital. In the past, the Faith Health was limited to those connectors operating from Wake Forest Baptist Hospital region and our monthly "Connector" meetings were around 20-30 folks. Now that number has risen to over 50. It is my hope that with the increase in resources, we will see new opportunities here locally and in our mountain regions.

In Faith Health news locally, I received our first donation of monies to assist patients with prescription copay funds and, if needed, transportations funds. I want to thank Warrensville Baptist WMU for these funds. This past month has also seen much activity in face-to-face ministry, along with online and phone calls. I took a little extra time to phone the clients we helped last month, just to follow up. For new clients, I assisted a 77-year old male veteran who was not taking advantage of the veteran services available to him. Another client was a 43-year old male that recently had a leg amputated. There are several other examples just like these.

Baptist State Convention of NC Annual Meeting. Because of the pandemic we changed the registration process to an online pre-registration process. As such there are no messenger cards mailed out like in times past. Roughly five weeks ago, our communication team mailed out a letter, and also send by email to each church, stating the new process for registration. In that letter it included the unique church id and pin number needed to register online along with the website address. The website address is <http://ncannualmeeting.org/register>. They will need the church id and pin number so if they do not have it, they can call us at 919-459-5555. If the church failed to submit a 2020 Annual Church Profile, they will default to only two messenger cards (if they gave anything to Cooperative Program). We can only calculate correct number of messengers if they report. If they have any questions about the registration process or Annual Meeting, they again can call the number. We encourage all churches to participate and we look forward seeing everyone there!

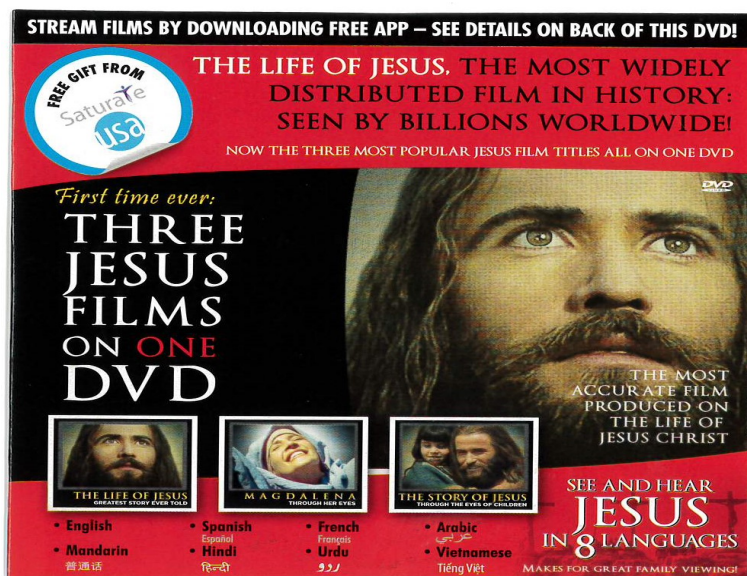

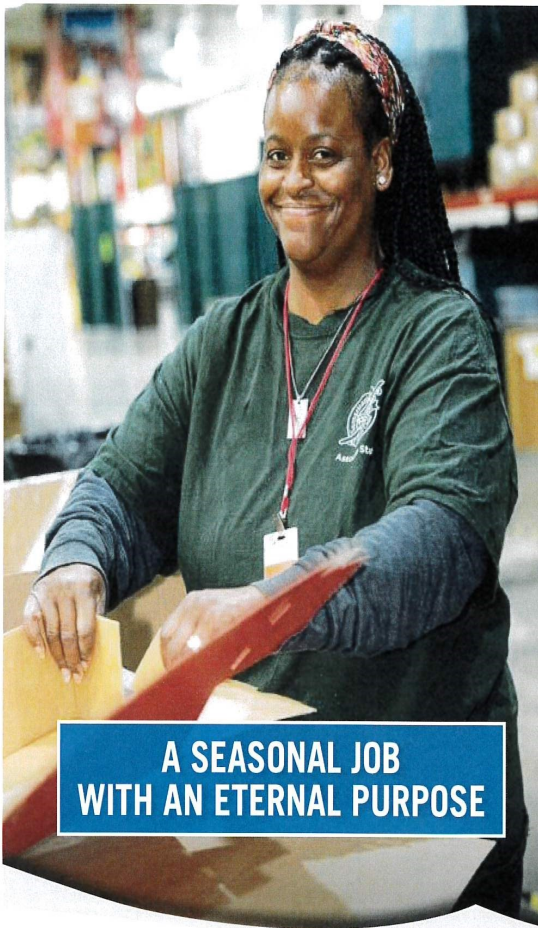

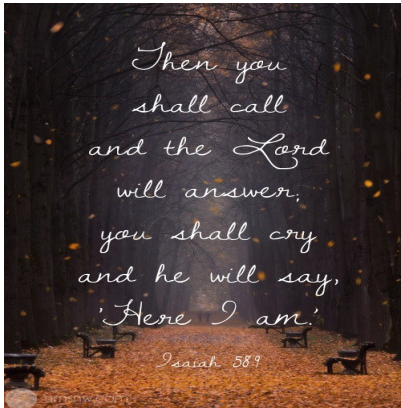
