Post 135th Annual Meeting of the Ashe Baptist Association

The Annual Meeting was a big success! I want to thank the Lord for the Holy Spirit that led us all the way. Thank you to Appalachian Church, Rev. Steve Ashley, pastor and the folks who worked so hard to host on Friday. Thank you North Beaver Baptist Church who hosted on Saturday, Pastor, Rev. Rick Miller and the folks who made us feel welcome. Special thanks to Moderators, Mr. Jerry Powers and Mr. Joe Brown. Thank you Mr. Butch Miller for playing the piano and leading the singing. Mrs. April Miller Hartzog led the singing on Saturday and we thank her as well. Her choir did an excellent job and she sang a powerful song that made us all cry. On Friday, App Church's Praise group blessed us with great music! We had great singing, great preaching, and great information for all to grow by and was well attended even with COVID going on. Friday we had approximately 90 in attendance and on Saturday 75. At least 24 churches were represented. Nine reports from the Baptist State Convention of North Carolina, its' Institutions and agencies. The reports was given to inform folks what is happening in North Carolina and around the world. We appreciate those who traveled to share with us. This is a great time to learn about the convention especially if you do not attend the State Annual Meeting in November. The history of both churches were read. A great message from Rev. Tom Graybeal was give from Acts 27:14 on What to do in a Storm. Rev. Ken Jones challenged us preaching on Jonah 1:1-17 dealing with Asleep during the Storm. It was great! On Saturday, Rev. Russell Hart preached on "As it was in the days of Noah". As with Noah, God has called us for such a time as this. Many prayers were offered especially for America, Hatti and Afghanistan. Our hearts are sadden by recent events. In new Business motion was made to encourage churches to set aside October the 17th for a special offering to pay off the debt of the office complex and again the same Sunday in October for two more years. The motion carried. The new budget was passed and Bristol Baptist Church was approved to host the 2022 Annual meeting on Friday. Tuckerdale Baptist Church already was approved to host on Saturday. Local reports were given on Saturday by the Director of Missions, as well as reports from Ashe Really Cares, Baptist on Missions, FaithHealth, Evangelism, N.C Baptist Women, Disciplemaking, Church Music, Historian, Baptist Campground, Vacation Bible School, Guide Stone ABA, Gideons, Ashe Pregnancy Care Center and Christ for all Peoples. Christ for all Peoples is a movement to give every family in Ashe County a copy of the Jesus Video on DVD, a track on how to be saved and a plastic bag to hang on doors if the family is not at home. We have those DVDs and tracks at the Associational Office. We hope to have a meeting soon to begin to distribute to all Churches, hopefully in October. I will be in touch September with information regarding distribution. All churches are encouraged to participate, if you believe in Jesus as your Savior we need your help no matter what denomination you are. We did this with the Lord's help a few year ago with the Jesus Video Project and I pray do it again Lord! Lost folks should be on the mind of every born again Christian. Perhaps the new DVD give away will encourage us to again visit homes and share the gospel. I refuse to give up and be asleep in the boat, to run away from God, or to not work because of the storm that we are in sometimes, like COVID. We are #ABASTRONG#! God is with us! I am encouraged and I hope you are as well. If you did not attend the Annual Meeting you can get a Book of Reports from the Associational Office. Be excited, ready to serve. 





ewis Smith is using his love of cycling to help break the cycle of abuse, neglect and abandonment in the lives of the boys and girls served by **Baptist Children's Homes (BCH)**. Lewis is undertaking a special cycling fundraiser called **Bike for Hope** to help meet the tremendous needs of vulnerable children in our state and beyond. At 71 years old, Lewis is pushing himself to new limits in order to see children receive the compassionate care they deserve.

Lewis' Goal: Bike a total of 600 miles to help children!

Bike for Hope takes place throughout the month of September. Lewis will ride his bike on a safe, perimeter road at **Charlotte Motor Speedway** in Concord. While he may not be able to pedal as fast as the NASCAR race cars that compete at the speedway, Lewis has a finish line of his own he is training to reach. **His goal is to cycle a total of 600 miles in a series of 12, 50-mile stages throughout September.** Lewis chose that distance because it is the equivalent of riding the length of the state of North Carolina. **Baptist Children's Homes**, a nonprofit that operates caring homes and ministries that stretch from the far east to the mountains of Western North Carolina, cares for children from all 100 counties. The distance Lewis is biking is a reminder of the hurting boys and girls Baptist Children's Homes is ready to serve no matter where they are in the state.
