Post 136th ABA Annual Meeting Information

The 136th Meeting was an excellent time of worshipping God, singing, hearing the Word preached, fellowshipping together, hearing reports of Southern Baptist work around the world and here at home. Thank you to everyone who attended with many of our 44 churches represented. Special thanks to Bristol Baptist Church and Tuckerdale Baptist Church for hosting. They took care of everything and the food was heavenly! We had preaching three times at our meetings and that helps the sessions to go smoothly. Truly we knew that we were in the presence of God which drew us into the presence of the King of Kings! Rev. Larry Shepherd, Tuckerdale Baptist Church, preached on HOPE, the theme of the meeting, "An Association of Hope" (Romans 15:13). Rev. Chuck Register from the Baptist State Convention of NC gave a report preaching on "Being on Mission Together"! Chuck shared that with 4300 churches that make up 78 Southern Baptist Associations in NC we need to "run to the cry"! Rev. Lonnie Carpenter, Pleasant Home Baptist Church, preached what I thought was the best sermon I have heard him preach. He preached on many cross references dealing with HOPE! He preached with a bad shoulder from a fall off his truck but that did not stop him. Rev. Steve Ashley, Appalachian Baptist Church, preached a powerful sermon on "You once, But now". This sermon was on HOPE as well. Truly great preaching at the Ashe Baptist Association Annual Meeting! Wonderful congregational singing led by Mr. Butch Miller, Christian Unity Baptist Church, kept us alive in the Spirit throughout both sessions. Special singing by Mrs. Pam Barlow and Crick Baldwin, Bristol Baptist Church and by Mrs. Kim Johnson, Tuckerdale Baptist Church, was most inspiring. Thank you all! We heard from nine folks who are with the NC Baptist State Convention, Institutions and Agencies. Paul Langston from NC Baptist on Missions shared many things but one thing caught my ear. One million meals have been given away in the Ukraine by Baptist on Missions. His report helps us stay informed on what is happening with Southern Baptist Men on Missions at home and around the world. We hear it right from the horses mouth, so to speak, first hand information not what we hear from other sources which may or may not be true. Saturday we heard seventeen folks sharing about what is happening locally in the Ashe Baptist Association. It is great to hear about all the activities that we may or may not be a part of. Exposure to these activities, keeps us learning about lots of work going on in Ashe Association and are thankful for folks at work in different areas serving God. We then can hear God's voice saying "you need to be doing this". He calls us to do things we never have done before. That is what our Annual Meeting is all about! We get exposure to different things and God's Holy Spirit speaks to us in a unique way. You and I are to grow in our walk with the Lord until God calls us home. We will work till Jesus comes! We approved a new budget for next year. Thank you to all the churches and individuals who give that we can continue God's work in the Ashe Baptist Association. We also approved Bald Mountain Baptist Church as the host next year on Friday, 2023 session of the Ashe Baptist Association. We need a church to host on Saturday, August 16. Last month we were able to help 91 families with food. This touched 212 individuals and we had 3 new families to come in needing assistance. With the clothing we were able to help 459 individuals. With school beginning to start back there has been families coming in to look for school clothing for their children.

We want to thank the folks who have brought in fresh produce from their gardens. This has helped families to get good nutritional food for their tables. Those who have brought in fresh chicken eggs have helped many of our neighbors, this is a food item we can not get from Second Harvest at this time, so we are so excited to get eggs!!!

We had had several homeless folks drop by the office needing food and clothing. Right now we have two that are in tents and one staying wherever they can find a place. Sometimes we take for granted that we have a place to stay.

We would like to give a shout out to the gentleman who helped fix the problems with our van that we use to pick up food in. Also thank to everyone who helped with the cost of repairs. Our van is a very important piece for the workings of the ARC. Without it we would have a difficult time getting our food to the ARC. Without the van and our faithful volunteers we would be at a stand still. You touch families even when you don't see them. Thank you all so much.





The Creator of the Universe, who created you, has a perfect plan that He ordained for your life. That does not mean that it will be an easy one. It is safe to say however that you were born for such a time as this. He is perfect and makes no mistakes, though we sometimes do.

As we live in a time that questions our God's competency and ability, our foundations of the faith can be assaulted causing stress, anxiety, marriage and family difficulties etc. God's Word is our life manual showing us how to overcome these stressors in this hour.

I started ministry in Mid-Town Manhattan, at The Lambs Church and Saint Paul's House. The area was known as "Hell's Kitchen". This exposed me to individuals who were struggling with addictions, homosexuality, transgender identity and homelessness before these issues had a national focus. I have been a Christian Counselor and have been in Prison Ministry for many years. In 2015, I accepted a Therapist position in Maximum Security prisons for youth in Florida. I worked on three Sex Offender Units and with the general population of prisoners. Most were gang members. I have a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science from Northeastern University, a Master of Public Administration and a Master of Social Work from West Virginia University. I am trained in Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) and held three daily groups for Life Skills and Addictions. I also had an individual client case load of 12 prisoners on average. Individual sessions were geared to individual needs and family sessions.

In 2020, I moved to Maggie Valley, NC. I continued private counseling there as well as accepting a position as a North Carolina State Member at Large for Haywood County. I have recently moved to Ashe County. I feel very blessed to be here and feel very much at home.

No one therapy is right for everyone. However as believers, with the freedom to apply biblical principles to our lives, we can find a peace that is not available in the world. No matter where you currently are in your life, you can know that sessions are confidential and you will be treated with respect. God loves you and we can explore His answers for your life together in a safe environment.


