

What is ACCCP?

The Ashe County Children's Christmas Project brings joy up to 1,000 Kids. Ashe County, NC — In the heart of the Blue Ridge Mountains, a spirit of unity and compassion shines brightest during the holiday season. For over a three decades, the Ashe County Children's Christmas Project has brought smiles, warmth, and hope to children with disabilities—making Christmas a little brighter for those who need it most.

Led by the Ashe Baptist Association, the project has grown into a \$220,000 community-wide effort that touches the lives of up to 1,000 children across the county. These children, all living with 100% disability, face unique challenges every day—challenges that can feel even heavier during the holiday season. But thanks to the generosity and coordination of local churches, schools, businesses, government offices, and countless individual donors, these children are reminded that they are not alone.

The project is not about charity—it's about dignity, love, and joy. Each child receives hand-selected Christmas presents and a backpack filled with age-appropriate items like books, hygiene products, school supplies, snacks, and toys. These thoughtful gifts are more than just things—they're a message to every child that they are seen, valued, and cared for.

This is about the whole community coming together "We have churches of every denomination, small businesses, schools, county employees, and individuals from every walk of life who step up to help. It's truly a county-wide mission of love. It restores my faith in mankind.

Volunteers spend weeks preparing—shopping for gifts, packing backpacks, organizing donation drives, and ensuring that each package is tailored to the child receiving it. Age, needs, and personal preferences are all taken into account, making every gift meaningful and personal.

For many of these children, Christmas morning is a time of wonder thanks to this program. The twinkle of excitement in their eyes, the laughter echoing through their homes, and the joy in their families' hearts are reminders that compassion can truly change lives.

We just don't want any child to be sad at Christmas," says a longtime volunteer. "No matter their circumstances, every child deserves to feel the magic of the season."

In Ashe County, that magic is real. It comes delivered by a community that believes in lifting each other up. Through faith, unity, and love, the Ashe County Children's Christmas Project continues to bring the true spirit of Christmas to life—one child at a time. We are the hands and feet of Jesus.


