# Courtland Band Parent's Association <br> General Meeting Minutes <br> October 19th, 2021 

I. Call to Order - 7:36 PM
II. Since last month's meeting minutes were not emailed out prior to the meeting, Secretary summarized the last month's meeting. Upon completion, meeting minutes, from last month's meeting, were approved.

1. A fundraising letter has been created and will discuss later in the meeting.

2. Upcoming events
a) VBODA State Marching Assessment will be this Saturday. Info can be found online and expects the kids to be home by 2 pm . This is the most important marching performance for the season and everyone has to be there! Schedule plans: report to Courtland at 8am, start warm-ups at Massaponax at 10:45am and then performance at 11:45am.
b) Football game vs. Eastern View, at home, is scheduled for next Friday, October $29^{\text {th }}$.
(1) As of $\mathbf{1 0} / \mathbf{2 3} / 2021$, the date of this game has moved from Friday to Thursday (10/28/2021). Game will still take place at 7 pm and will still be at home.
c) Powhatan Competition will be $10 / 30$
d) Spotsylvania Band Showcase will be $11 / 1$ at 7 pm
(1) All 5 marching band will be performing that night
(2) There is no admission fee, but asking for a donation to help the Treasure house, which helps homeless students of Spotsylvania County
e) Last football game of the season is $11 / 5$, at home against King George
f) We have been asked to play music as Santa arrives to the mall on $11 / 13$
(1) It was determined this was a JMU Open House day for any prospective students, so we may not have some seniors at this event.
g) Christmas Parades will be $12 / 4$

6. Fundraising Events
a) Car Show-planning to be moved to the Spring
b) Bingo-might plan this even in February
c) November Calendar (described by Mr. Mills
(1) The kids will get a 'write in' calendar and the goal to have one person purchase each day on the calendar. Every cent will go back to the band versus only a \% coming to the band from a cookie, fruit, etc fundraiser. All money from this fundraiser will go directly to the overall band account (not the kid's separate accounts). There will be a raffle for the kids who sell a full month. Discussion on the calendar being on an envelope, with the picture of the band. If any checks are collected, they should be made out to CBPA.
d) Future: maybe have a band yard sale and then have a donating organization take the rest. Maybe be a part of the 208 yard sale weekend next year.
e) Looking to get some 50/50 raffle baskets going. Mr. Mills suggested the boosters to write the email to admin in order to get this fundraising opportunity approved. Band used to have concessions, so this would be a great opportunity for fundraising during football games. There would be 2 parents, signed up through Sign Up Genius, with aprons to see the 50/50
raffle. Then the winner would be announced during halftime or $3^{\text {rd }}$ quarter. Sonia plans to look more into emailing admin and this fundraising opportunity.
f) Idea was brought up: for maybe the month of January or February to have skills by the kids auctioned off. Babysitting, raking leaves, baking a cake, etc would be auctioned off to allow us to earn money for the band.
g) Future forward: Mr. Mills said he could build a fundraising group.
