Have you been paying attention or do you go into a sort of haze thinking about what is next in the service and getting settled in for worship? Our calendar is full for October! Take a moment and really look at all the activities coming up! Fellowship's Purpose and Vision statements are played out in all these activities. Have you taken a moment to look at this lately? Yes, it is on the front of the bulletin each week and also on the rotating announcements on the television in the narthex.

Purpose: To share God's love and grace through our words and actions.

Vision: To be a diverse, thriving community of faith where all are welcome to celebrate God's love and grace.

There is a phrase that is in both that is the key to both "**God's love and grace"**, not ours but God's. All the lessons for September 28 reflect what God wants us to do, not what we want to do. Even though we are a small congregation, have you reached out to the visitors among us? One Sunday, did you notice the gentleman who came in at the end of the service, went up the side aisle, then knelt in prayer? Likewise, do we ignore the Lazarus' in our lives? What other ways of reaching out can we do?

Yes, we will take time to celebrate much at the end of the month, but we need to celebrate and share **God's love and grace** every day, not just one day.

If there are relational activities you would like to do, let leadership know. We need **your** input on what type of activities you want to do.
