



As we close the second quarter of 2024, our financial situation is stable. Our current Unrestricted Cash balance is \$24,612.49. We began 2024 in a very positive position with an Unrestricted Cash balance of \$24,648.13. As expected, we had a peak in March when we received a large full-year donation that gave us a large increase in our cash assets. As the last several months have progressed, you can see the expected decline in the unrestricted cash as that donor's former monthly contribution is no longer coming in.



The following chart shows our income by month and you can see that our monthly income is down compared to prior years, again mostly due to the one-time annual gift. The monthly trends are tracking comparably to prior years. We'll probably see some decrease in income during the summer months.



Our income continues to benefit from increases in the interest rates we are receiving. We included increases in interest income in our budget plans. We again received over \$450 in interest in the second quarter. I continue to balance our bank accounts so that we maximize the amount in our money market account to get the most interest income, while maintaining plenty of cash in our checking account to cover our ongoing expenses.

Our expenses are tracking very closely to our budgeted amount through the first half of the year. We are underspending our budget by about 2% for the quarter and the first half of the year. The largest contributors to our expenditures are our salaries and benefits, our mortgage, and utilities.

Our bank accounts hold \$47,590.47 of cash on hand. Of that, \$24,648.13 is unrestricted that we can use for any of our operating expenses. Again, our Unrestricted Cash is trending comparably to prior years, with the exception that we received the one-time pre-paid contribution from one family which has significantly increased the balance for now. It will decline faster as the year progresses since we have already collected that one, large contribution.

On the liability side, our mortgage balance is \$243,051.73. We have reduced the mortgage by \$2534.12 during the second quarter.

During the second quarter, we have done some significant things to improve our facility. We have resealed our driveway. We employed Hope Through Housing to weed and mulch our garden beds. We also did a major clean-up of the many accumulated things inside our church. Some of what we cleaned out was thrown into the trash, but much of the furniture and stuff like that was recycled by our next door business neighbors. We have also helped our neighbors through a significant number of gifts to people coming through our doors seeking assistance in their difficult, trying times. The need is great in our area and many more people are needing help. We continue to contribute to the Smoky Row Food Pantry to help them meet those needs.
