In her Advent devotional, Kate Bowler writes,

He was born to save us—and he will—but first he must melt our hearts, appearing not as a sage or a philosopher or an emperor but as a cold little child with no home. He disarms us with his tender vulnerability and summons us to enter his world as little children, too...

Now that 2021 has shaken our world all over again, our inner desires and deepest needs are revealed. We see the world as it has always been. And we are here, waiting with bated breath for the kingdom of God to break in. This is the season of almost. We learn to sit in the faint glow of a long Advent, the shorter days and endless nights. This is the season for all of us who need that extra hour of darkness, preferably under a blanket near the Christmas tree, to feel the immensity of what we've gained and what we've lost...And as we anticipate Christ's birth together, may we experience the stubborn hope of Christmas, joy in the midst of sorrow, a love that knows no bounds, and a transcendent peace amid a world on fire.

Jesus can't be born soon enough.
