Greetings FLC members and friends,

As I write this newsletter article, I was notified a few hours ago that Fellowship has lost her first

member to COVID-19 after the member contracted the virus in a local nursing home. This was the second person I've known personally who has had coronavirus. There have been probably more that I've been around who have been asymptomatic carriers of the virus since many people who are carriers of the virus are without symptoms. Having coronavirus hit "close to home" has reinforced my belief that our church council made the right decision a couple of weeks ago when we decided to hold off for another month for in-person worship.

We are fortunate that as a congregation, we have never been closed during this pandemic. We are able to worship God weekly with our online worship services to which almost all of our members have access. It's definitely not my preferred way to worship - I miss your smiling faces and the fellowship we have together. But I believe we are being faithful to the commandment that we should love our neighbor. By gathering online right now, we are protecting those who are most vulnerable in our congregation and keeping each other safe.

We will be watching closely in June the effects of "opening up Ohio" on the number of new coronavirus cases and deaths. Our council will meet again on June 16th to reassess the situation. We have tentatively set a date for in-person worship in our building as July 5th. We also have thought about outside worship before then, but the road noise from Sawmill Rd. is great, even on Sunday mornings.

Meanwhile, as a church we are preparing for the return to in-person worship. In late June, the church will be deep cleaned and sanitized throughout the building. Our lawn care people from Hope through Housing will be weeding and mulching outside in the next couple of weeks. If you would like to make a contribution to help out with these costs, you are more than welcome. We have placed three hand sanitizer dispensers in the church, and hand sanitizer will be available in the entrance-way and in the sanctuary. Also we will be removing chairs from the sanctuary to provide for physical distancing. Hymnals and fellowship records will be removed from the sanctuary for the time being. Other changes to expect: a requirement that everyone except those under two wear a mask, including the pastor and worship servers (except while preaching or leading worship). We will not have singing for a while because research has shown that aerosols from singing spread even with a mask. Masks will be available if you don't have one. We will probably also start out with biweekly

communion using prefilled communion cups and wafers (with grape juice). And for our plan to safely work, it will be necessary for everyone to closely monitor his/her own health and not come to church if ill. We will inform you of other changes prior to our first services back together. I miss you all greatly, pray for you often, and look forward to seeing you soon! Take care!
