Dear Fellowship Members and Friends,

I can't believe how fast this year is going! I remember as a child how time seemed to pass so incredibly slow, but now it seems like in a blink of an eye, almost a half year has come and gone. I hope as we enter the summer

season, you will come to church as often as you can to be fed and nourished. If you want to sleep in on those lazy summer days, there's always the 5:00 p.m. service to attend! We'd love to have you come and worship with us in the relaxed, more intimate atmosphere that allows one to concentrate on the music (from Augsburg's Worship and Praise Hymnal), the word, and time around the table of the Lord. Healing Service on June 5th at the end of worship during both services! In the rite of healing, the church does not replace the gifts of God that come through the scientific community nor does it promise a cure. Physical healing may or may not follow the laying on of hands. Nor does the lack of a

cure reflect a weak faith or that a person has not found favor with God. Rather, the church offers and celebrates gifts such as these: God's presence with strength and comfort in time of suffering, God's promise of wholeness and peace, and God's love embodied in the community of faith. The healing service on the 5th will be an optional part of worship that Sunday at the end of our worship service. If you would like to participate, just remain in the sanctuary after our last hymn. If not, you may quietly exit during the last hymn. This is not the type of healing service that you might have seen on television with the person falling to the floor but a gentle laying on of hands, prayer, and/or anointing with oil for those who choose. We encourage everyone to experience the power of a healing service - we are all broken people in need of some kind of healing.


