

Greetings Fellowship members and friends!

On Ash Wednesday, February 22nd, the season of Lent officially began. Lent is a season of prayer, reflection,

repentance and renewal. It is in this annual pilgrimage to the cross of Calvary that we are reminded of God's ultimate sacrifice for our eternal life. As we set aside time for our own spiritual practices, we remember God's incredible love for us and the tremendous sacrifice of Christ who gave His life for us.

Lent provides us the opportunity to step out of our often busy schedules to examine once again the direction we are headed in our own faith walk. 


