

2022 Q1 Financial Update

Thank you for your support of Fellowship so far this year. Thanks to your support, our worship income is 105% of our estimated income for the first quarter. As you can see on the chart below, our available cash assets are tracking just about the same as last year. This is a pretty good start to the year. As you can see, it is typical that our available assets trend downward over the course of the year.



In 2022, we committed to increase our benevolence to the Southern Ohio Synod from 7.5% of our worship offering to 8%. We gave \$2,745 (8% of our worship income) to the Southern Ohio Synod to support them as they support us. In addition to congregational support, the Synod also supports area ministries such as Lutheran Outdoor Ministries of Ohio and Campus Ministries at OSU, Capital and other area colleges. This quarter we also gave \$260 to LSS Food Pantries for the Souper Bowl. Thank you for all your contributions there. Too bad the \$240 that we gave to show our support for the Bengals didn't help them win the game.

We also paid off our part of the roof repairs. The \$32,170 of our insurance claim was paid out to the roofers. That has completed our responsibility to the roofers for their work.

We have been entrusted with \$20,000 dollars from Grace Lutheran Church of Pennsylvania. Their church closed and they made us beneficiaries of the proceeds from a portion of the sale of their assets. They have entrusted us to use these funds to support our local community. Our Outreach Team is currently working on what organizations to disburse those funds to that would align with the goals of Grace Lutheran's members. These monies are being held in a restricted fund to be allocated and disbursed in accordance with their vision.
