Group 3: Charles 'N Charge (Crenshaw Christian Counselors)

Charles, Sr. and Chandra are 45-year-old psychologists. They met at The Chocolate Factory during a class trip with their children's school two years ago. They were instantly attracted to one another and began dating immediately. Charles is divorced and has three children: Charles, Jr., age 13; Camryn, age 10; and Cephas, age 8. Chandra's son is Camryn's classmate. Chandra keeps all of the children bi-monthly and spends the weekend at Charles' house.

Chandra dislikes being left alone with Charles' children because they are very disrespectful. They refuse to do their chores, homework, or anything else she asks them to do. She mentioned their behavior to Charles, Sr. but he has not taken her seriously. Periodically, Chandra leaves Charles, Jr. with the children to shop, run errands, and enjoy date night with Charles, Sr. Charles, Jr. complains about being left alone with the children who do not listen to him; his grades and behavior at school has declined.

Charles, Sr. recently proposed to Chandra. They have come to you for premarital counseling. Develop a counseling plan. Advise them.

Group 4: iDream of Jackie (PAPs)

Diane and Dennis met ten years ago at a sports bar near school. They tied for first place in a Jell-O shot competition and knew they were a match made in heaven. They got married during their senior year of college. Shortly thereafter, Diane found Dennis' treasure chest that contained pornography blockbusters. She confronted him about the movies and he invited her to watch them with him. She agreed. They decided to mimic some of the "stunts" from the movies and Dennis found he especially enjoyed Diane in handcuffs. During their nightly excursions, he would handcuff her to the bed and periodically "spank" her with nunchucks.

For the past year, Dennis and Diane's excursions have drastically declined. When Dennis comes home, Diane is usually sleeping peacefully and responds harshly to his attempts to awaken her. Dennis has become attracted to other women, but loves his wife so much that he decides to seek counseling. During a counseling session, Diane - a big fan of martial arts - confessed that Jackie Chan often appears in her dreams naked. This disrupts her sleep pattern, but their porn collection helps her to relax. Now, she is not romantically interested in her husband. Save Diane and Dennis' marriage.

This case is one of many similar incidents presented during your group session to show the problem many pastors are having with pornography. 


1 Corinthians 6:16-20

And don't you realize that if a man joins himself to a prostitute, he becomes one body with her? For the Scriptures say, "The two are united into one." 17 But the person who is joined to the Lord is one spirit with him. 18 Run from sexual sin!
