Dear Mr. Terry,

It has been twenty-five (25) days since Mr. Fishbane presented his Investigative Report for Mason Classical Academy (MCA) to the Collier County Public School (CCPS) Board. As you may know, MCA's charter contract with CCPS requires CCPS to notify MCA, in writing, of any alleged default of contract and shall give MCA thirty (30) days to cure. To date, the CCPS Board has not notified MCA of any alleged default of contract, nor has the CCPS Board provided MCA with thirty (30) days' notice to cure any alleged default under any provisions of the charter contract. Notwithstanding the aforementioned facts, the MCA Board has scheduled a Board meeting on July 2, 2019 to address the alleged defaults contained in Mr. Fishbane's June 3, 2019 Investigative Report.

Additionally, would you please provide answers to the following questions?

1. By what authority did Mr. Fishbane recommend MCA board members and staff members resign?
2. Prior to disclosing his report on June 4, 2019, did Mr. Fishbane notify anyone else of his specific allegations? Did he discuss with anyone else the proposed recommendations?
3. Why didn't Mr. Fishbane include in his sixty (60) plus page report any recommendations to cure his alleged defaults?
4. Why did Mr. Fishbane not properly attach his investigative report to the June 4, 2019 meeting agenda?
5. Did Mr. Fishbane or other CCPS staff members release his unredacted investigative report to anyone? If so, to whom and when?
6. Did Mr. Fishbane receive both Hillsdale letters, dated June 6th and 17th? If so, did he or a staff member release them to anyone? If so, to whom and when?
