Games-Dottie Hughes: Dottie drew a name for the October golf clinic: Connie Rogers. She announced that next year there would be no drawings for a free clinic, but that there will still be clinics scheduled for 2019 at a \$10 fee.

Dottie then presented the year-end awards, and announced the Ace of Aces for 2018 is Norma Gupton. All other award winners will be listed on the AWGA website.

Dottie drew for the November free clinic which went to Terry Freeman.

Handicaps/GHIN – Norma Gupton: Norma announced the 2018 Most Improved Award went to Donna Lutman.

Tournaments – Donna Doss: Announced her committee would be Shirley Hudson, Brenda Conrad, and Diane Johnson, with Lynda Duvall serving as Rules. She is currently finalizing 2019 tournament dates with the courses and will email that information at a later date.

Rules - Lynda Duvall: Lynda presented a video that covered the 2019 golf rules changes. In her next email she will include a link to that video and added that there is information on the USGA website.

In follow-up questions, she noted that in competitive play we will continue to play out-of-bounds as lateral hazards in order to speed up play; lay out from the spot your shot went out of bounds, and proceed to hit from that spot with a one-stroke penalty.

With regard to bunkers, you may move your ball within the bunker (1 stroke penalty) or declare a ball in the bunker unplayable and re-hit from the original spot (1 stroke penalty), or (new rule) opt to drop out of and behind the bunker (2-stroke penalty).

Playdays – Maggie Williams: This year the Playday Chairman will organize playdays with participating volunteers assuming responsibility each month. Volunteers will be provided with information and supplies to organize and run the playdays.

The 2019 schedule of playdays is on the AWGA website. Maggie emphasized that players arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start and be prepared to drive to their designated tees by 10 minutes prior to the tee time.

Old Business

Dottie Hughes (Games) reminded everyone to sign AND date their scorecards, and each group should turn in two scorecards in order for the Games Chairman to verify the scores input on the playday sheets.

New Business

Donna Doss announced that any player requesting a handicapped cart MUST produce a handicap placard or other identifying information to the Pro Shop, which will be kept on record.
