PLAYDAY CHAIRMAN

Golf Genius software is used to set up our play days (tournaments). AWGA has a laptop used for this purpose.

At the start of each year the calendar is set up in Golf Genius with dates, games, points, etc., subject to Board approval. Email Delivery for Signup Openings and Closings is also set up through Golf Genius.

Signups will open at 3 pm after our weekly play day and closes the following Friday at 10:00 am. After signing up to play, a confirmation e-mail is sent to the player.

Pairings are made in Golf Genius and tee sheets are emailed to only Confirmed Golfers. Tee sheets can be sent via Communications/Gmail if deemed necessary (if there is other news to report to the membership).

The confirmation email includes the method to cancel, if required, and should be sent as soon as possible. The Chairman may designate a contact to receive last-minute cancellations in order to realign pairings. Re-sorting of pairings is only done if threesomes can be converted to foursomes (at the request of the pro shop).

At two of the courses we play there are two tee boxes to choose from (Tierra Verde and Lake Arlington). Players must choose their tee upon arrival; tees played should be clearly marked on the scorecard and cannot be changed once the round has started.

According to USGA Rule 3.3, "After the round, the player and the marker (who keeps the score) must certify that the player's score for each hole is right....." After play, two scorecards are turned in per foursome to help the scoring process should one of the scorecards not be readable. Each foursome must total their scorecard before comparing scores, ensure that each hole scored matches the other scorecard, sign, attest and date each scorecard. The time that your foursome finished their round should also be marked clearly somewhere on the scorecards.

Scores are entered at the clubhouse, flights are made based on the number of players, winners are calculated and scores are posted to GHIN.

The Playday Chairman may establish a committee to assist in any of the above tasks, which also includes Quarter Pots for birdies, chipins & low putts. Playday Chairman presents Eagle pins, in addition to any AWGA member that breaks 100, 90 or 80 for the first time.

Playday Chairman oversees Ace of the Month. They also provide a number of games played to help Handicap Chairman with Most Improved and Tournament Chair with Club Championship criteria.
