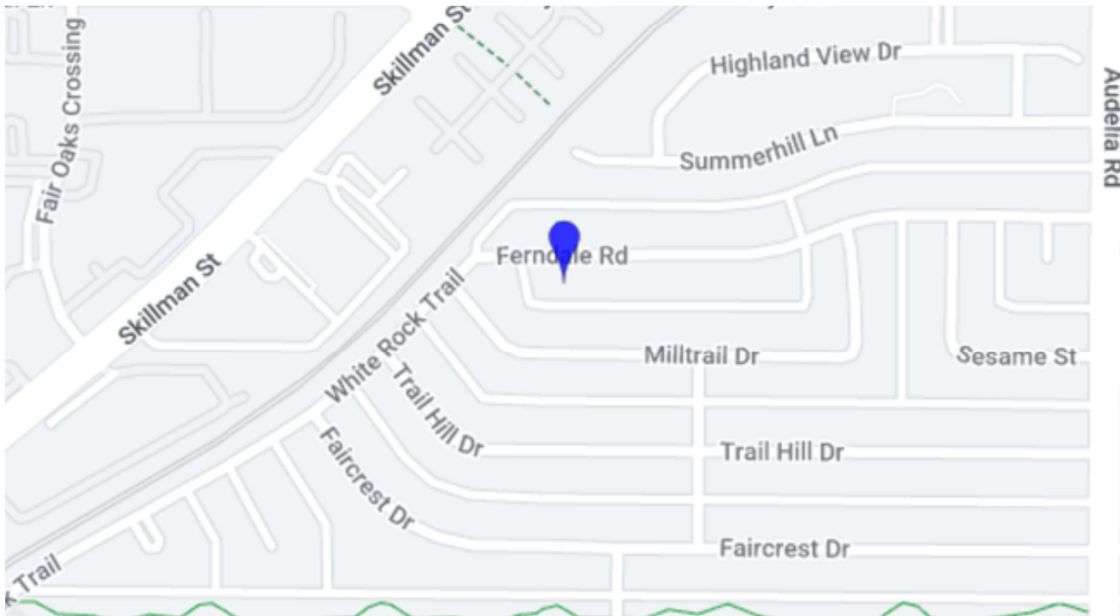


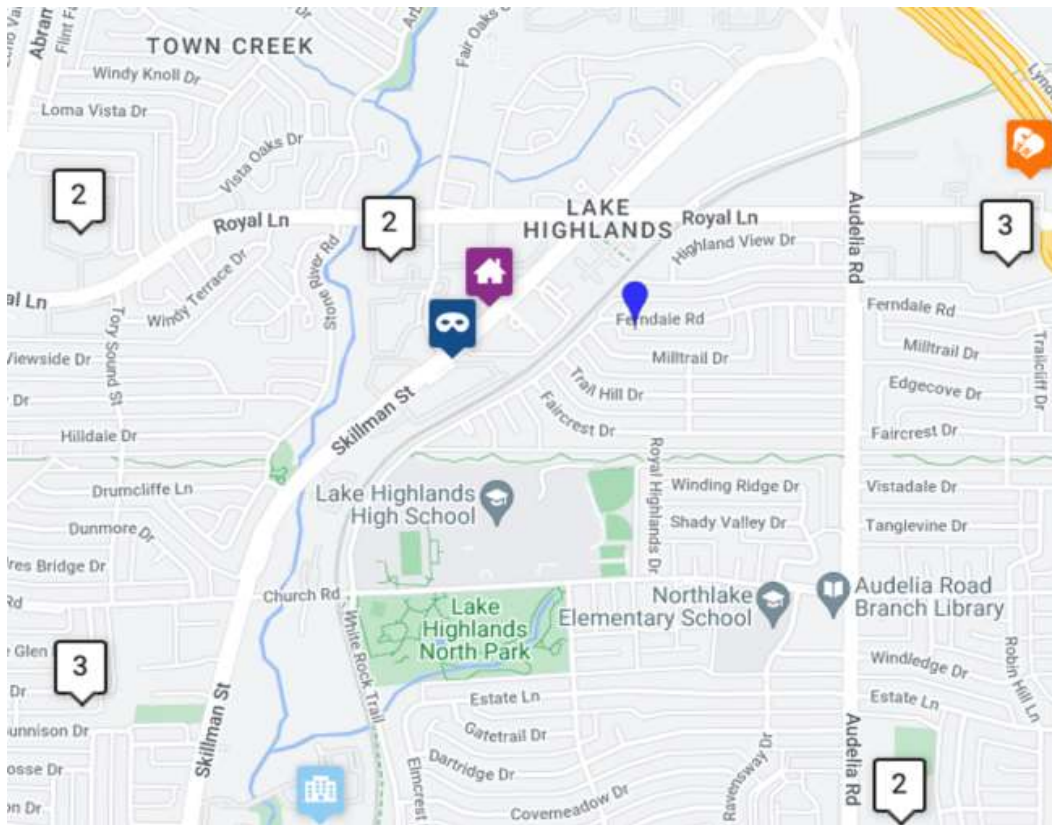


Royal Highlands Homeowners Association June 1, 2024

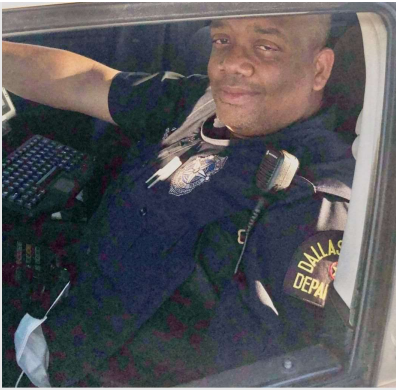
## Creepy Criminal Caught Creeping Around
