

Bible Reading Plan

Do this daily

Ephesians 6:10-20

We are in Spiritual Warfare! We must guard our heart, mind, and body from satan's attacks. Satan uses lies to trick us. We must believe, whole heartedly, in God's truths! We need to come to a place where we place God before anything. People will fail us, offend us, hurt us - but God is true always. The more we search and yearn to know God, the more satan will attack. We need to be ready and only through God's strength and power can we be prepared to face the enemy.

The Whole Armor of God

10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. 11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil. 12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places. 13 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm. 14 Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, 15 and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace. 16 In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one; 17 and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, 18 praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints, 19 and also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel, 20 for which I am an ambassador in chains, that I may declare it boldly, as I ought to speak.

1 Corinthians 3:16-17

16 Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you?

17 If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy him. For God's temple is holy, and you are that temple.

Galatians 6:6-9

6 Let the one who is taught the word share all good things with the one who teaches.

7 Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap.

8 For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life.

9 And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up.

Hebrews 12:1-6

Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,

2 looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.

3 Consider him who endured from sinners such hostility against himself, so that you may not grow weary or fainthearted.

4 In your struggle against sin you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding your blood.

5 And have you forgotten the exhortation that addresses you as sons? "My son, do not regard lightly the discipline of the Lord, nor be weary when reproved by him.

6 For the Lord disciplines the one he loves, and chastises every son whom he receives."

2 Corinthians 12:7-10

7 So to keep me from becoming conceited because of the surpassing greatness of the revelations, a thorn was given me in the flesh, a messenger of Satan to harass me, to keep me from becoming conceited.

8 Three times I pleaded with the Lord about this, that it should leave me.

9 But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

10 For the sake of Christ, then, I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

I created this reading plan based on books of the Bible God used in my life, or books I've wanted to spend more time in, or even books I know have some good stuff!

Our minds must be transformed and renewed - daily.

This world only offers temporary satisfaction. We need to change our mindset that even through hard times - God's truth remains. When everything is going wrong - God's truth remains. In the good - God's truth remains. When we struggle - God's truth remains.

Christ came down, lived perfectly, died and rose again for US! Salvation is not earned, and there is nothing that we can do - EVER - to win God's favor. Works are good, but they are just works. Works are a product of faith and not a foundation for faith. We can do everything in our power to "check off" the box that says we have faith, but until we are living in God's power it will not be fruitful.

Why I chose these verses for us to turn to when we are struggling, need encouragement, or just need a reminder. Much like some of the books chosen for these 90 days.

1 Corinthians 3:16-17

We must remember we are God's. Bought with a price - Christ's sacrifice on the cross. We need to keep ourselves holy. We must guard our heart, mind, spirit. Satan will attack when we are trying to live righteously. He is our enemy. We have the Spirit in us. We are God's. God defends His own. I know this verse is primarily speaking on keeping ourselves pure, but I think it is a great reminder that we are the Lord's!

Galatians 6:6-9

This is to remember that we cannot fool God. He knows everything. Seen and unsee (or so we think). We need to remember all our choices have consequences. If God is not our PRIORITY then our choices will reflect that. Living a life that glorifies God is hard. We are not perfect. We will not live perfectly. God knows this. But He has liberated us from sin - not to sin, but to be free from sin. Let's trust Him. His plans for us are perfect and he truly knows best.

Hebrews 12:1-6

This is my verse for the year. I have been working on "laying aside every weight and sin". We have to remember that people are always watching us. Not just because they can see there is something different with us, but because they are waiting for us to fail. They are waiting to see our God "fail us" - and God never does. Trials enter our life to strengthen us, to test us, and to glorify God. In order to live this life we need to be willing to sacrifice everything - wealth, relationships, desires and more. God has made the ultimate sacrifice, so whatever sin or thing is being prioritized before God, or is being desired before Him MUST be sacrificed. This always reminds me of the rich young ruler (Matt 19:16). He could not give up his earthly possessions to follow Christ, so he turned away. May we be willing to put God first!

2 Corinthians 12:7-10

This is to remember that even in our weak moments, God is strong. He needs to be our strength. He needs to be our everything. Pride stands between us and God. We must humble ourselves to lean into God's strength and realize we cannot do anything without him.

May we prioritize God daily. May we walk in faith. God's word is powerful, all-consuming, and transforming.
