Did you know that Sugarvalley Neighbourhood Centre has an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)?

AEDs provide first aid treatment for life-threatening instances of cardiac arrest. The AED assesses a patient's medical situation and then delivers a measured electrical shock to restore the normal effective cardiac rhythm, if required. All staff at the centre are trained to use the AED.

The AED is located at the entrance to the back hall.


WALK TO D'FEET MND HUNTER

SCHOOL OF HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCE SHARE THE DIGNITY FUNDRAISING EVENT

The School of Humanities and Social Science at the University of Newcastle held a fundraiser for Share the Dignity on 21 May 2019. Money raised went to Share the Dignity and products donated were sent to Sugarvalley Neighbourhood Centre as an official Share the Dignity collection partner.

Associate Professor Trisha Pender discussed the importance of the work the school does on violence against women, in particular through the work of the '16 Days of Activism to End Violence Against Women'. Dr Xanthe Mallett talked about her work with victims of domestic violence as a forensic criminologist. Dr Mallett also discussed the importance of the next generation of workers in the fields that work with domestic violence survivors being engaged in ground-roots movements as well as being informed academically.

Professor Catharine Coleborne as Head of School discussed the importance of looking at the impacts of domestic violence on all of us as people, noting the way the university as a whole and the School of Humanities and Social Science in particular are working both academically and practically to address these issues.





Commonwealth Bank Donation




