The counter-clockwise movement signifies unwinding or undoing harm, reversing patterns that, directly or indirectly, have been destructive to all of us. The flow begins with acknowledging the humanity of every person (heart), to working for the good of each one of us (hand), to a more honest telling of our national story (book), and ultimately toward the achievement of peace and freedom for all (dove).
