## American Hornbeam (Carpinus caroliniana)

## TREEE APPEARANCE

Form: rounded to broad spreading,

may be multistemmed

Mature height: 20 - 30 feet

**Spread:** 20 - 30 feet

Flowers: catkins hang on leafed-out tree in April

Fall color: variation in color, from

yellow to orange to red

Fruit: small nuts hang in papery sacs in clusters

**Growth rate:** slow

## **CULTURE**

**Soil:** moist to average soil; tolerates

moderate drought and occasional wet soil

**Light:** sun to full shade

## **NOTES**

Sometimes called Ironwood or Musclewood for its unusually hard wood; does well in shade; tolerant of air pollution
