H is for Honor

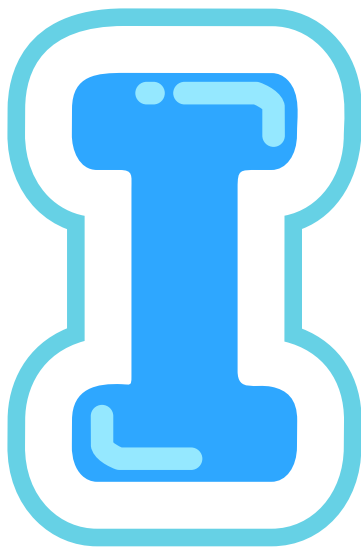
Ephesians 6:2 (ICB)

Ephesians 4:32 (ICB)

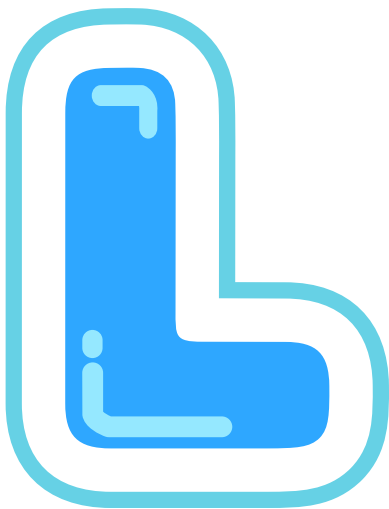
“Be **kind** and loving to each other. Forgive each other just as God forgave you in Christ.”

Matthew 6:33 (ICB)

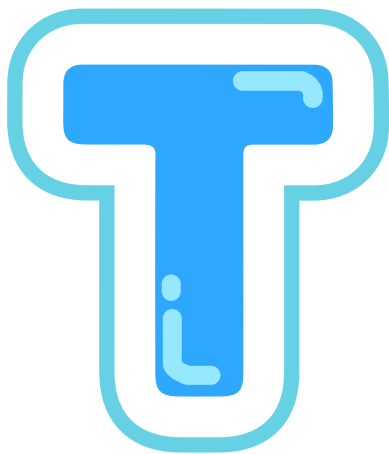
“**Seek** first God’s kingdom
