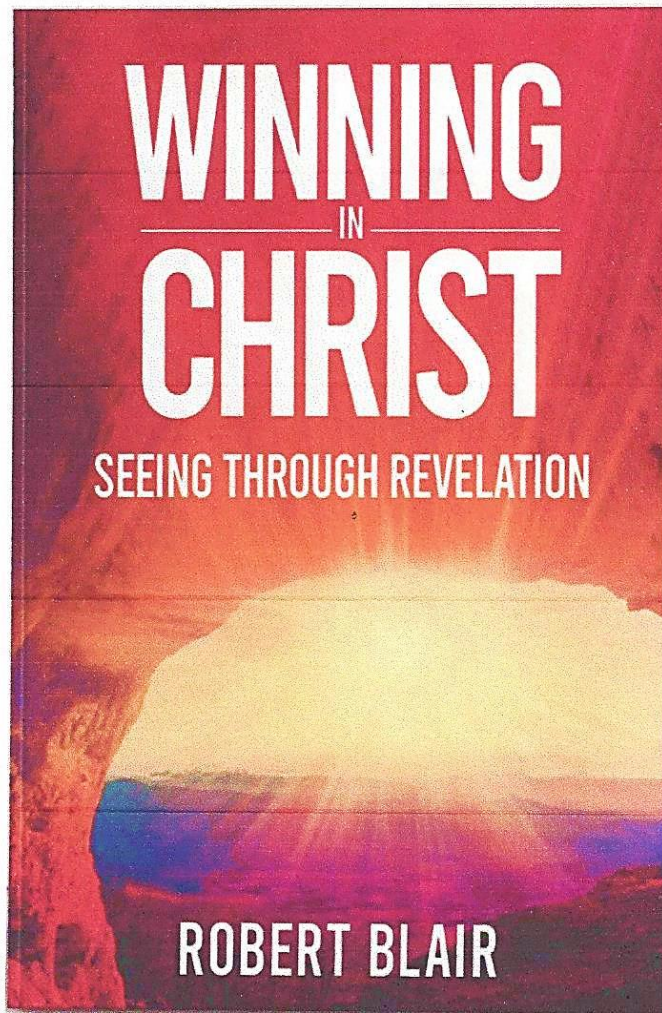


**Coming in JANUARY, God willing**

The letter also presents solutions to many current societal hiccups. In Christ, all distinctions diminish; Jesus redeemed people from every tribe, language, people, and nation.
