One of Calvin's disciples, John Knox, convinced the Scottish parliament to adopt Calvinism. In 1560 they embraced a book of discipline and confession of faith similar to the ones used in Geneva. Thus, Parliament created the Scottish Presbyterian Church.

Many churches now follow Calvin's teachings. Most Baptist churches, Reformed churches, and many Evangelical churches accept Calvin's TULIP points regarding salvation. In the TULIP acronym, "U" stands for Unconditional Election. Saying it simply, Unconditional Election means that God has already decided which of us will be saved and which will be condemned. No human effort can change God's mind.

On this point, Calvinists completely misread Romans 8: 29. What God predestined or elected is that to be saved, we must conform to the image of Christ. "Christ in us is the hope of glory." I pray that all our readers and their loved ones make that their chief goal. We start by reading Jesus' Sermon on the Mount in Matthew 5-7 and following his teachings throughout the Scriptures. Jesus wants us to serve him, not money or Satan.
