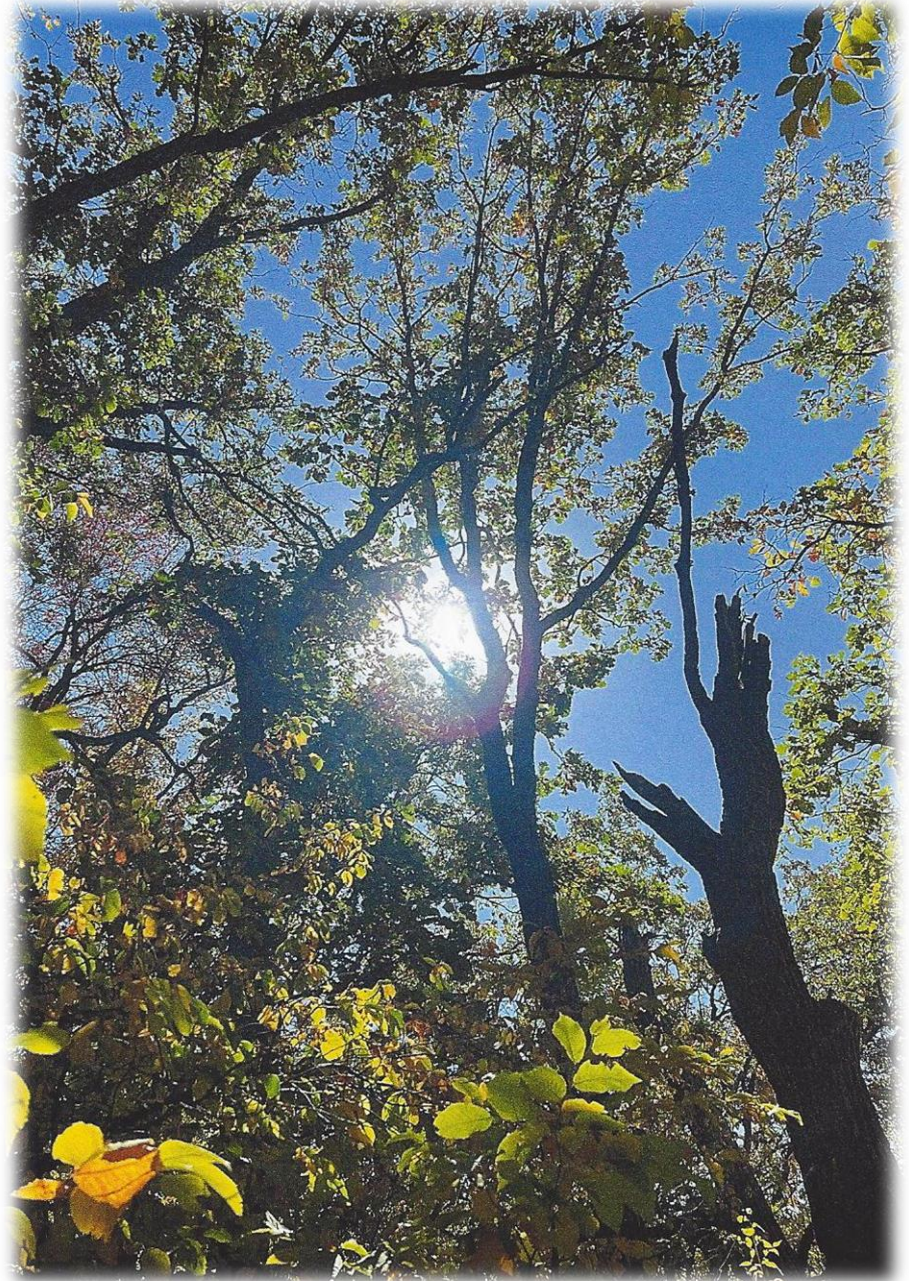

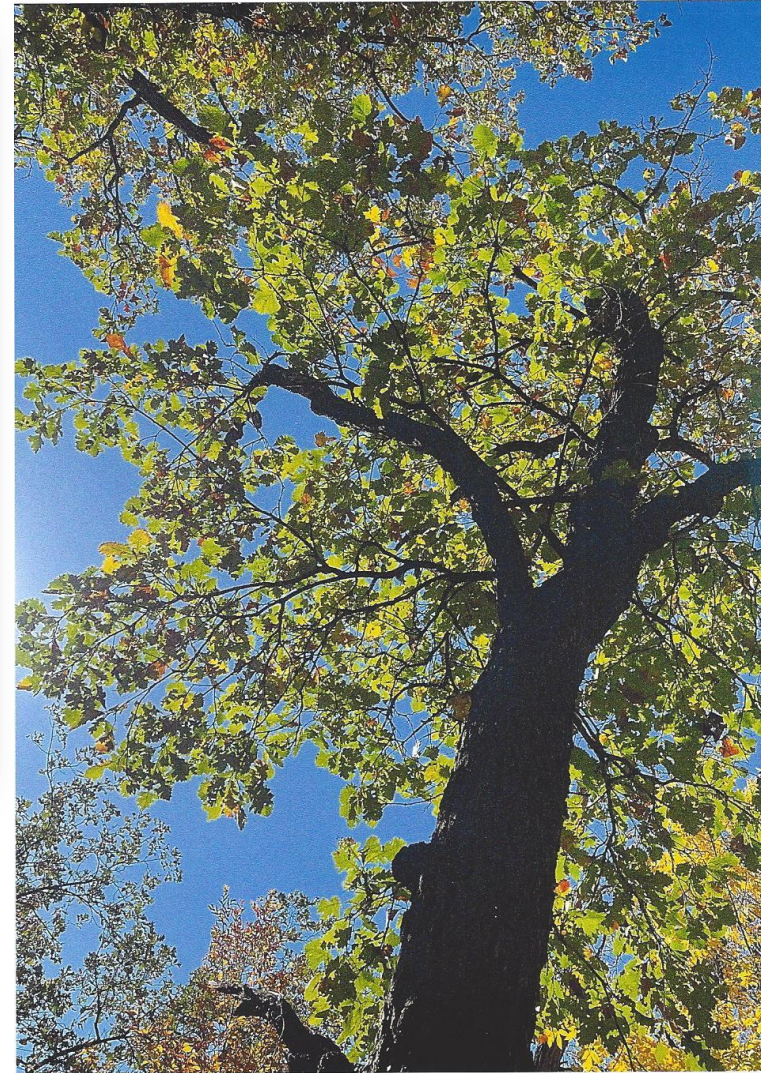


**"The Mighty One

God also designed the flowers that beautifully grace planet earth.

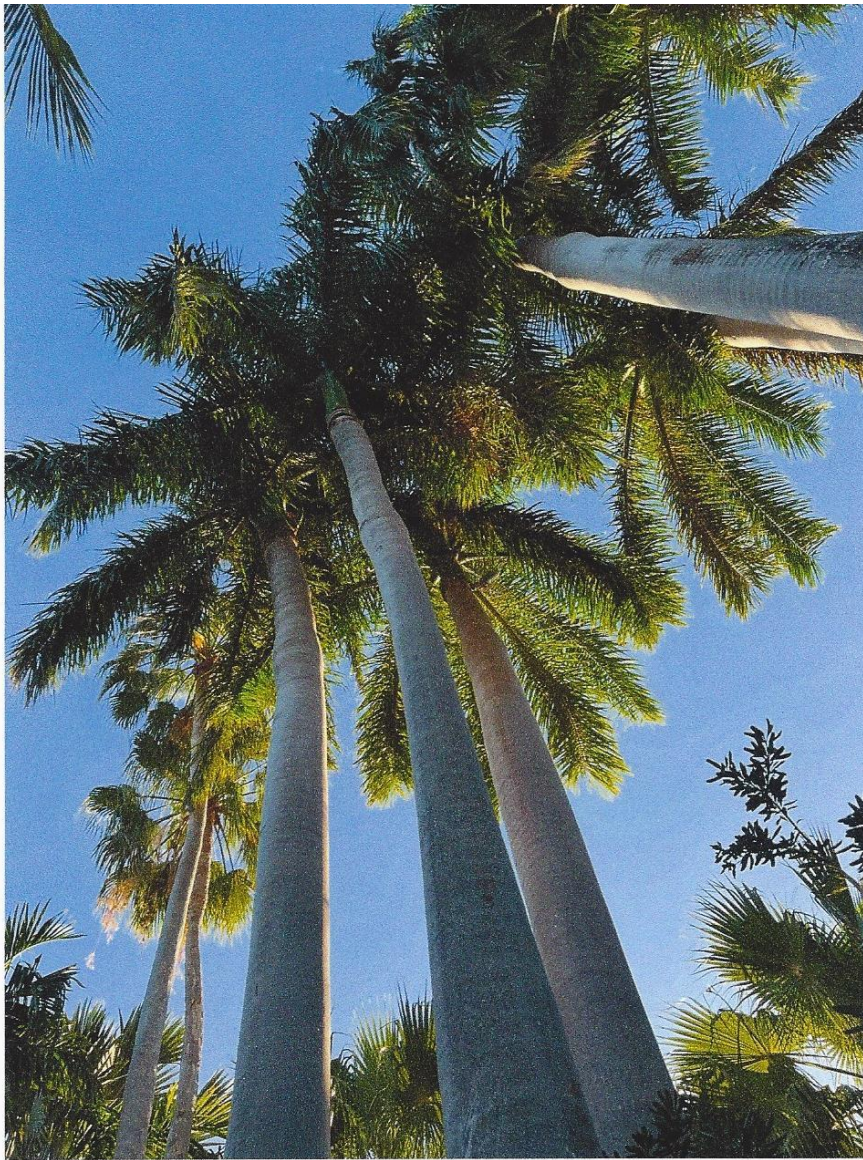


As the earth spins, it seems to us that the sun rises and sets every day. Christians should especially note sunsets.

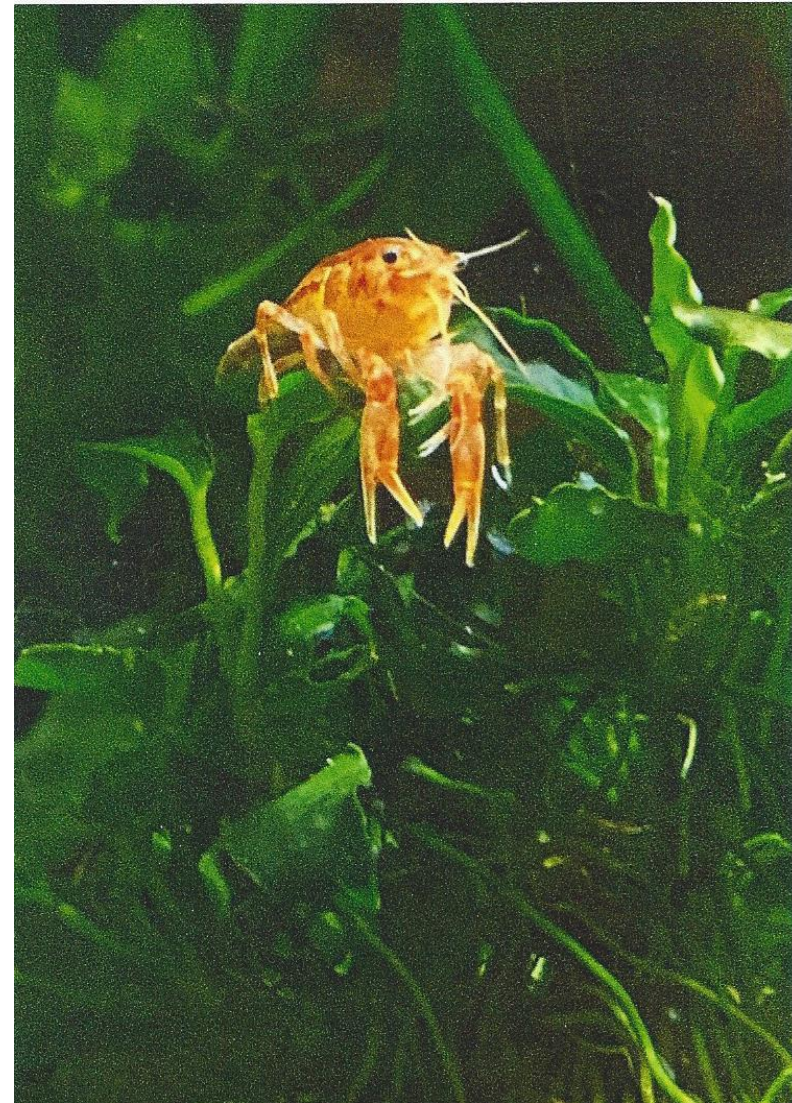
Why?
