Volunteers.... CACS requires that all volunteers maintain current PA Child Abuse and PA Criminal Background Checks. Volunteer roles include volunteer coaches. field trip chaperones, and helpers for PTO events and other special activities held during the school day. Obtaining both clearances is free for volunteers, and clearances are deemed current for 5 years from issue date. 

A.L.I.C.E. Training

At CACS, providing a safe learning environment for our students is a top priority. All CACS staff members are trained with A.L.I.C.E. (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate) program. As we have done in the past, we train our students for a possible security emergency. The training is not meant to disturb or scare our students but to educate them on how to react if needed. If a violent critical incident occurs, students and staff may need to utilize multiple strategies. We want to make sure that everyone understands their options. Training will be age-appropriate. Between Oct. 14- Oct. 31, we will read I'm Not Scared...I'm Prepared! by Julia Cook to our K-8th grade students. Students in Grades 9-12 will watch an age-appropriate ALICE training video focusing on the ALICE acronym. For more information about the ALICE model, please visit www.alicetraining.com.
