Summer Reading Incentive Program – June 1 to August 17, 2025

We are excited to invite your child to participate in our **Summer Reading Incentive Program**, designed to foster a love of reading in students from **kindergarten through 12th grade**. While **participation is not required**, it is **strongly encouraged** as a meaningful way to build strong literacy habits that benefit students for years to come.

Elementary students (K-4) will track their reading progress by coloring in fun images on reading logs. Each image represents 20 minutes of reading. These age-appropriate and engaging logs make reading fun and easy to monitor.

Middle and high school students (grades 5–12) will track their progress by logging the total number of minutes read as well as the titles of the books or materials they have read using either a print log or the Bookmory app (free version). This encourages independent choice and allows students to explore genres and topics that interest them.

To recognize our readers, we will hold a **prize drawing during the first week of school**. Students who submit their completed reading logs will be eligible for tickets based on how much they read:

- 1,100 minutes (20 minutes/day, 5 days/week) = 5 tickets
- 660 minutes (20 minutes/day, 3 days/week) = 3 tickets
- 440 minutes (20 minutes/day, 2 days/week) = 1 ticket

In addition, high school students who log at least 660 minutes of reading this summer will also earn a "Special Assignment Ticket," which allows them to be exempt from a project assigned during the first nine weeks of the school year.

Reading logs or Bookmory App screenshot must be submitted to teachers by Friday, August 22nd to be considered for prize drawings and eligibility.

We encourage you to support your child in this summer adventure: encourage them to read, to read what they love, and to read often. Developing a passion for reading will enrich their vocabulary, strengthen their imagination, sharpen their thinking skills, and give them tools for success that will last a lifetime.


