
CACS ALTERNATIVE SUMMER READING ASSIGNMENT LITERATURE GRADES 9-12 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR



Your project is due on the first day of school. Failure to turn this assignment in on the first day of school will result in a penalty of ten percentage points per school day that the project is late.
