
All students in Grade 10 will be taking the PSAT test on the morning of Monday, March 9<sup>th</sup> at CACS. Students will be taking the PSAT on their school assigned Chromebook, which should be fully charged for the test.

The PSAT is a nationally recognized standardized test that provides first hand practice for the SAT, which is an essential step in the college admission process. For those who may not plan on pursuing higher education, listing PSAT testing in a resume or portfolio also demonstrates a level of maturity and seriousness to potential future employers. The PSAT measures the areas of critical reading skills, math problem-solving skills, and writing skills. PSAT results provide feedback on areas of academic strengths and weaknesses to students, teachers and administrators.


