CACS Student Symptom Screening Tool

Use this tool daily to determine whether your student is experiencing any symptoms that require him/her to stay home from school.

What is your student's temperature (taken before medication is administered)?

Is your student taking any medication to treat or reduce a fever such as Ibuprofen (i.e. Advil, Motrin) or Acetaminophen (i.e. Tylenol)?

Is your student experiencing any of the following?

Group A 1 or more symptoms	Group B 2 or more symptoms
Fever (100.4 or higher) Cough Shortness of breath Difficulty breathing	Sore throat Runny nose/congestion Chills New lack of smell or taste Muscle pain Nausea or Vomiting Headache Diarrhea

Please keep your student home if he/she:

☐ Has one or more symptoms in Group A OR
☐ Has two or more symptoms in Group B OR
☐ Is taking fever reducing medication.

Your student must be fever free (without the aid of medicine) for 24 hours before returning to school. If your student is diagnosed by a doctor or clinic with a specific illness, please notify the school.
