

DUAL ENROLLMENT GUIDELINES FOR CACS STUDENTS

2022-2023

CACS students in Grades 9-12 have the opportunity to earn college credits by enrolling in the Lock Haven University Dual Enrollment program. Dual Enrollment provides a wonderful opportunity for qualified high school students to earn college credits at a substantial tuition discount of 75%.

Dual Enrollment Guidelines

- Students desiring to participate must be maintaining a GPA of 3.0 or higher at CACS.
- Students may not have any disciplinary actions
- Students must keep up to date with all scheduled CACS coursework and assignments

Option 1: Travel to the Clearfield LHU Campus

- A minimum of two Dual enrollment courses per semester (one must be an in-person class) for students in Grades 11/12 is required.
- Transportation to the LHU campus is NOT provided by CACS.
- Dual enrollment students are required to report to CACS each day for attendance.

Option 2: Online only courses

- Students in Grade 11/12 may participate in online only LHU dual enrollment courses. These courses will not be completed during school hours, but at home.

How does this work with my CACS Classes?

- Students in Grades 9-10 may only enroll in online courses during the school year. These courses will not be completed during school hours, but at home.
- Students in Grade 11 may enroll in morning In-Person courses at the Clearfield Lock Haven Campus. When participating in morning In-Person classes, you must be back at CACS by the 11:00 lunch period.
- Students in Grade 12 may enroll in afternoon In-Person classes at the Clearfield Lock Haven Campus which begin after the 11-11:30 AM CACS Lunch Period.
- Students in Grades 11/12 are required to participate in all CACS classes prior to the time of their departure for LHU and after their return from morning classes.
- Students in Grades 11/12 are required to travel to LHU at the same time each day. If one class is on-line, they will travel to LHU and utilize the LHU facility to complete course work.

How do I sign up?

- Set up an appointment with Mrs. Albert to discuss your desire and eligibility to participate in the Dual enrollment Program.
- Complete an admission application for LHU
- Bring in your permission form which lists your classes for Mrs. Manno's signature
