CACS JUNIORS AND SENIORS COLLEGE VISITS

Students in grades 11 and 12 are permitted a maximum of $\underline{3}$ days for college visits per school year.

Students must bring a note from a parent to the office prior to the college visit. The note should state the date of the visit and the name of the college being visited.

To qualify for an excused absence, following the visit students must turn a note into the office. The note must be on college letterhead, list the date of the visit, the students name, and must be signed by a college official confirming the visit.
