Dress Code Reminders

Khaki Shorts..... Starting May 1st, students have the option to wear khaki shorts with their dress code polo shirts. Shorts may not have extra pockets (cargo style) or cuffs and must fall within 1” of the top of the knee.

Jeans.....Reminder on Jean’s Day, jeans may be any color or pattern. Jeans may not be tight fitting and **may not** have any holes (even if there is fabric underneath) or visible fraying. No leggings.

Field Trip Dress Codes..For Knoebles, students are permitted to wear fingertip length shorts of any material. They may not be tight fitting, have holes (even if there is a patch underneath), or fraying. Students may wear picture shirts. Sleeveless shirts must be a minimum of 2” wide at the narrowest spot. No bare midriffs.

Onward and Upward... Remember that students are growing, and shorts, dresses, and skirts may not fit them the same way that they did in the fall. Shorts, dresses, and skirts must fall within 1” of the top of the knee even if leggings are worn underneath. Also, if your student has outgrown any dress code appropriate clothing that is still in good shape, please donate it to school for PTO’s Dress Code Clothing Sale.
