CACS COMMUNITY SERVICE

1 Peter 4:10-11: "Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms. Do not be slothful in zeal, be fervent in spirit, serve the Lord."

One of the essential goals we have at Clearfield Alliance Christian School is for students to develop the Christian Character of Servanthood. CACS encourages students to serve their community, their local church, and local agencies committed to serving those less fortunate. Community service is one of the requirements for graduation.

Guidelines for Community Service:

- Community Service hours MUST be pre-approved prior to completion
- Students are required to complete a total of 40 service hours

 Students should complete 10 hours of the total 40 hour community service requirement each year (Grades 9-12) by the last day of school
- Students need a minimum of 10 hours to be completed in the community with a non-profit organization.
- The remaining 30 hours may be completed through a church, CACS, or once again in the community (in addition to the required 10 hours of community hours)
- Service must be completed outside of school hours
- Seniors must complete hours of service prior to April 15 of their senior year
- Service hours completed during the summer will be credited to the upcoming school year

Documentation

- Complete a Community Service Form for each service activity
- Have the supervisor of the organization sign your form

Examples of Community Organizations: Living Bread Ministries, Local Fire Halls, SPCA, Charged Ministries, Food Pantries, YMCA, Habitat for Humanity, and Life Line Pregnancy & Infancy Services.

Examples of service with your Church: VBS, teaching/helping with Sunday School, etc.

Examples of service with CACS: statistician, score board, tickets sales, & cleaning crews.
