

Permanent Makeup Patch Test

Allergic reactions to the products are manifested through:

- Redness

If you have any of the above after your patch test, it means you have allergic reaction to a cosmetic product. Treatment cannot be completed.

If you don't develop any reaction(s), the treatment can be done. Keep in mind allergic reactions can develop at any time.

The patch test must be completed as soon as you receive it and no less than 48 hours prior to the appointment. If you do not comply with these instructions your appointment may be cancelled or rescheduled.

*a negative patch test will not guarantee that you won't develop an allergic reaction.

Pack Includes

- 1 Sample size of pigment stored in a small container
- 1 Sample size of numbing cream stored in a small container
- 2 Cotton pads
- 2 Cotton buds
- Record card

Test Usage Guide

Step 1: Using 1 cotton bud, dip into the **pigment** container and apply a small amount **behind your left ear**.

Step 2: Using 1 cotton bud, dip into the **numbing cream** container and apply a small amount **behind your right ear**.

Step 3: Leave the products on the skin for at least 48 hours.

Step 4: Remove the products with the separate cotton pads.
