AT HOME: 3 Easy Ways



Backyard

Add one part food scraps + four or more parts yard waste to a bin or tumbler and mix/rotate every few days for about six months. [free!]

Subscription Pick-up Service

Sign up with a container swap company for regular at-home pickups. [fee based]



Village Drop-off Service

Take your food scraps to any one of Winnetka's 6 current drop-off sites: Greeley School, Hubbard Woods School, Washburne School, New Trier's Winnetka Campus, Winnetka Congregational Church, and the Elm Street Train Station [free!]
